



- **4.** It should take you no more than one week to finish a book that is on your reading level.
- **5.** Communication skills are one of the top skills employers look for when they hire workers.
- **6.** Students who leave middle school reading on grade level are significantly more likely to succeed in high school, college, and careers.

The research is clear: students who read more are more successful in school and in life. Now that you know, what will *you* do about it?



Motocross – the greatest sport you've never heard of | Ozzy Hacker (7th)







Yes, I know it's football season. I know basketball is starting soon, and hockey has already begun. But I want to talk about a sport that has changed my life – motocross. Motocross is the 3rd most dangerous sport in the world. This sport takes time, practice, and skill, Motocross is favored by many but remains a very uncommon sport. Only 37% percent of the world "likes" Motocross. I'm in that 37%, and I hope you will be soon, too!

Motocross was formed in the U.K in 1906. It used to be known as "scrambles racing" in the U.K, but as it formed its popularity, the sport became known internationally as motocross. The first known race ever was held at Camberley, Surrey in 1924. The sport grew to great popularity in the 1930's. By the late 1960's, Japanese motorcycle companies began challenging the Europeans for supremacy in the motocross world. Suzuki claimed the first world championship for a Japanese factory when Joël Robert won the 1970 250cc crown.

The sport evolved with sub-disciplines such as stadium events known as supercross and arenacross held at indoor arenas. Classes were also created for all-terrain vehicles. Freestyle motocross (FMX) events where riders are judged on their jumping and aerial acrobatic skills have gained popularity, as well as supermoto, where motocross machines race on both tarmac and off road. Vintage motocross (VMX) events are held for motorcycles usually predating the 1975 model year. Many VMX races also include a "Post Vintage" portion, which usually includes bikes dating as far back as 1983. There are 5 types of Dirt Bike brands Yamaha, Suzuki, Kawasaki, Husqvarna, And KTM.

If you haven't seen a race before, or can't find it on TV, a good way to get an idea for the sport could be through video games. According to critics, these are the best motocross games: Motocross Madness 2, MTX Mototrax, MX vs. ATV Reflex, MX Simulator, and MXGP: The Official Motocross Game. You can find these games on PS3, XBox 360, PC, and Wii. Just keep in mind, because you're going to get hooked and want to try it at home, that motocross is a very dangerous sport! If you choose to join, please make sure to wear all the required gear and ride at your own risk! Happy racing, future motocrossers!

Here are some highlights and a glimpse into the life of a person who gets to do this for a living. Enjoy!

How long have you been working at MTV? I've been writing for MTV.com since July this summer, so it's been about 3 or 4 months.

What is your job title there? I am a social listener, so it's my job to use a lot of software and website access to see what stories are trending and what stories could go viral tomorrow. It's my job to look at those stories and compare them with our brand of MTV and determine if that fits our readers. Then I send that off to all our other talent editors to see if they want to write about it, and if they don't have time to write about it, I'll write about it myself. It's kind of like a modern day assignment editor.

What are the perks of working at MTV? Oh my gosh, like endless, I love it here! Basically there's just a lot of high profile people you get to work with. On a typical day you get these great people strolling through the office. Ed Sheeran was here this week. Zed was here like two days ago. We are located in SoHo, New York, which is the fashion district, so there's a lot of cool events that happen right around the corner, so that's another perk is the location of our office. So for example, the Kardashians launched that app and that website at the Apple Headquarters in SoHo, so we just walked around the corner to go see the Kardashians. Viacom is also a very generous company to work for. They are nice to their writers!





Did you ever imagine yourself working at MTV? Actually yeah! I loved the musical world, wanting to be a musician, so for our college paper I'd reach out to all kinds of celebrities and they were always willing to do it.

Have you ever seen any shows being filmed? I'm in our office in West Village in SoHo, but we've got an office in Times Square. Any time I'm in Times Square, I make sure to stop by the sets and stuff where Nev (from Catfish) and all those guys hang out. It's actually weird I was in the bathroom the other day and Nev was in there. When I first started, my desk was completely empty and the only thing on it was this big binder. I opened it up and it was like an entire script for the show Teen Wolf!

Who is your favorite celebrity that you've seen so far? I worked at a few newspapers before this, one was in Nashville and one was in Ann Arbor, MI. When I was in Nashville I got to work with Carrie Underwood, she was very cool. I don't know if you've ever heard of Miranda Lambert, but I got to work with her. Paralyzed Man Can Feel Again

On September 17th, 2015. a prosthetic hand connected to the brain allowed a paralysed man to feel again. A 28-year old man who suffered an injury to the spinal cord and has been paralysed for more than a decade, can now feel after 10 years. It was reported that the prosthetic has been able to help him sense physical sensations. Electrodes were connected to the main sensory cortex of the brain, which is the part that allows the brain to sense tactical sensations. Electrodes were also placed on the patient's motor cortex, which controls the movement.

Wires were run directly from the hand to the electrodes, which was developed at the John Hopkins University applied Physics Hospital, in Laurel, Maryland. Using this type of technology, the man could control the hand the same way he would normally, i.e., with thoughts and neural connections. This milestone was announced by DARPA in the "Wait, What?" Technology Forum. "Prosthetic limbs controlled by thoughts are showing great promise, but without feedback traveling back to the brain it can be difficult to achieve a full level of success," said Justin Sanchez, the program manager for DARPA.

In addition to the prosthetic technology, DARPA's RAM program, (Restoring Active Memory), is possible to read and intercept key signals in memory processing and improve memory. Using implantable devices in the brain, the program hopes to improve upon memory loss. This implant uses electrical stimulation to awaken the brain's hidden memory with therapeutic effects. So, what do you think, do you like the way the world is going?

Earthquake in Chile!

The day is September 16th and everyone is minding their own business, either working, driving home, or even being with their family. But then everything started to shake! A powerful 8.3 earthquake hit the coast of Chile. The earthquake caused power to go out and caused major tsunamis along the coast near the epicenter (which was Coquimbo). Luckily citizens started to evacuate before any waves started to crash on shore. There were at least 5 people dead, and 20 people injured, leaving 1 million people evacuating their homes. the earthquake has caused tsunami warnings for places all the way to New Zealand, which is 6,000 miles away according to CNN. It's not just New Zealand that has tsunami warnings, however, as it has even caused beach closings in California. Places like Hawaii, Alaska, Russia, and Japan have tsunami warning as well. There were at least 12 aftershocks each that registered 4.9 or higher. Perhaps the only silver lining is that it wasn't as deadly as the one that hit in 2010.

Napa Farmer Wins Giant Pumpkin Contest!

On Saturday, October 3rd a napa farmer won a Northern California contest with a record-setting pumpkin of 1,806-pounds. The nickname of the pumpkin was "The Flying Saucer" because of its wide and flat shape. The pumpkin was entered into the Elk Grove Giant Pumpkin Festival in California. Five years ago on October 13th, 33 men were brought above ground after being trapped in a mine for two months after it collapsed on top of them. You might be wondering why I am writing about this if it happened five years ago? That reason is because the tragedy is getting its own book and movie that will be released in November. I think this is great news, and bringing this story to the masses will shed light on a very tragic situation. Let's recap those events briefly:

A day after Urzua had entered the dangerous and weakening mines, the time was 1:40 when he heard the clanging of tools ready to fall.
