- Any extenuating circumstances that may affect your family's finances, such as medical issues or job loss? Any recent shortfall in your family's financial situation is worth mentioning.
- Whether you were raised by a single parent or in a foster home.
- Whether you are a first-generation college student.
- Whether you or your parents are immigrants or refugees.
- Whether you or your parents speak English as a second language or not at all.
- Any other information that you feel would help the committee in understanding your financial need.

1. List all extra and community activities.

2. List all academic awards, achievements, and honors.

3. List all work experience.
