- 2. The novel is a frame story, like *The Great Gatsby*. What advantages and what disadvantages are there to using the frame story format?
- 3. What does your group think that the title might mean? (Your answer will of course be a guess.)
- 4. What is your group's reaction to the dialect used in the conversations in the book?
- 5. What are the townspeople's reactions to Janie when she returns to Eatonville in chapter 1?
- 6. Describe Janie in these first chapters. What is her personality like? How did she first "discover" that she was black?
- 7. There's a great poetic passage about a pear tree in bloom on pages 10-11. READ IT ALOUD in your group and discuss what you think it means.
- 8. Make a family chart of Janie's parents and (one set) of grandparents, based on the details that are revealed in the second half of chapter 2.

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
