<u>**Hypothesis**</u> – This is my best guess about what will happen.

Sample: I think that ______ will occur when ______.

<u>Research</u> – When I looked for information, what did I learn?

Sample: Can I find out what scientists say about how many days it takes for mealworms to change to beetles?

Procedure – Step by step, how did I conduct the experiment?

Sample: 1. Purchase two containers of mealworms.

- 2. Place in clear container with original packing materials.
- 3. Count number of mealworms in container.
