READING/LANGUAGE ARTS:

THIS WEEK IN READING WE WILL BE FOCUSING ON CONNECT TO EXPERIENCE OF OTHERS. ONE OF OUR READ ALOUD FOR THIS WEEK IS WILFRID GORDON MCDONALD PARTRIDGE. YOUR CHILD MAY HAVE HOMEWORK ON OCCASION THAT INVOLVES READING FOR 10-20 MINUTES. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!! IF YOUR CHILD IS HAVING DIFFICULTY, JUST ENCOURAGE THEM TO TRY, OR READ A BOOK TO THEM.

Spelling: Formal spelling has started. We are on Unit 2 of our Sitton Spelling. Our Sitton Spelling words for this coming week are (of, a, to) extra words: (in, it, is, me, mom, am, on). If your child is having trouble, please watch for a

slip of paper to come home with the word(s) they need extra help on. The words for this week are: (the, of, and, am, an, at, as, a, I, to)! There is also a dictation sentence every week on the spelling test. We will have a practice test on Wednesday and a final test on Friday. If they pass on Wednesday they will not have to take the test on Friday. I will take the highest score from both days.

Writing: We are diligently working on improving our handwriting. You may also see homework regarding handwriting. Remember forming the letter correctly is very important. We have also begun to write and identify complete sentences. This coming week our focus is on naming parts of a sentence.

Math: We have jumped right in to our Math Investigations and every student is really enjoying all the wonderful learning activities that go along with each session. This coming week our focus is on comparing numbers and addition story problems.

Please watch for Family News Letters from our Math Investigations to start coming home. These letters will explain all the wonderful learning that will take place in each Unit.

Science: This week we will continue to learn about animals and their habitats.
