# Discover

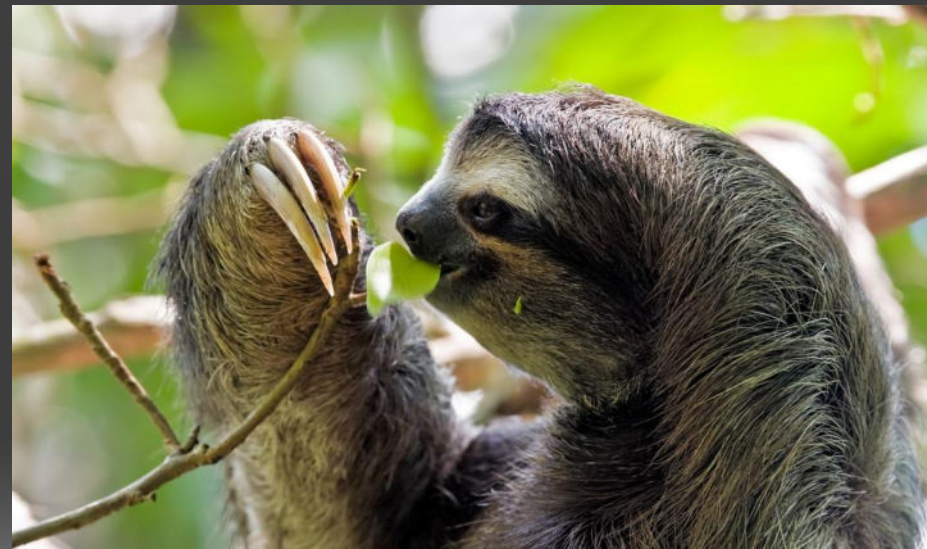
You have 10 minutes to think of some objects and make a list. Give the list to a friend and ask them to classify them.
