Because we realize that school ended unexpectedly last year, many of our scholars require extra help. The intervention program adopted by the district and our school is FRECKLE. Teachers make assignments for classes to complete based on current skills being taught that scholars complete online daily. There is also a very important component of the program called ADAPTIVE SKILLS which is specific to each child's individual needs. We MUST ensure that not only are scholars getting online to complete class assignments, but also the Adaptive Skill activities. The adaptive skill activities give them opportunities to experience skill work at their individual ability level and works to grow them toward their expected grade level mastery.
