State Remote Learning Plan Attendance



On remote instruction days, attendance is determined by daily evidence of student engagement with instructional content. This includes but is not limited to:

- Attending and participating in synchronous class instruction, class meetings etc.
- Evidence of engagement with class materials on Canvas based on Canvas analytics and Student Interactions reports
- Submission of assignments
- Completion of assessments

At the secondary level, attendance is monitored daily for each class.

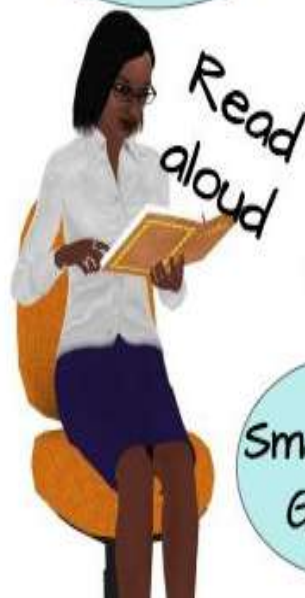

What is Canvas?

Canvas is an Online Learning Management Software Program. It is available through any web browser or as an app on your smartphone or mobile device. It streamlines classroom work to one location where teachers can post and grade assignments, and students can complete work and receive feedback from teachers. Canvas was adopted by the State of North Carolina in 2014 for all public school districts. UNCC (University of North Carolina at Charlotte), CPCC (Central Piedmont Community College), and NCVPS (North Carolina Virtual Public Schools) have also adopted the use of Canvas.

Scheduling, Testing, Drivers Ed Updates

Driver's Education

- ★ BTW Learning & Teaching will restart Aug. 17 for students who completed the Classroom portion last school year or this summer
 - BTW is done based on age & completion of course
 - Students must complete BTW before turning 18
- ★ Classroom instruction will begin with an online format in September.
 - Students must be 14.5 years old by 1st day of class
 - Registration & Info is at www.jordandrivingschoolcharlotte.com → will be live soon

Scheduling

- ★ Counselors are working to ensure all students have a complete schedule.
- ★ Students were placed in courses based on their course requests
- ★ Schedule changes will only be available due to error (sequence, incomplete schedule, etc.)

Testing

- ★ Hopewell is now a National SAT site for Saturdays! Register at collegeboard.org
- ★ All students in AP courses should receive a code to register for the AP exam from their teacher in the 1st two weeks -- students must register by October for the exams.
- ★ No news regarding state testing yet -- semester exams will be the week prior to Winter Break (Last 5 days of the semester).

UNC System Updates & College Info Sessions

- Changes to Minimum Admissions Requirements:
2.5 weighted GPA or **19 ACT** or **1010 SAT**
(any of these criteria alone make a student eligible)
- UNC System is **test-optional** for 2020-2021 year
 - students will not have to submit a test score with their applications
- Upcoming Parent and Student College Info Sessions
 - Beginning after orientation and every two weeks
 - Topic 1: Match and Fit and Building a College List
 - Topic 2: College Essay Writing
- Senior Packets - to be handed out at schedule pickup
