Smart Goal I: Subject ELA

At the culmination of the 2025 academic year, as mandated by the state of North Dakota, students in grades 3, 4, and 5 are expected to elevate their proficiency levels on the English Language Arts (ELA) summative assessment from 24% to 30%.



Smart Goal 2: Subject Math

At the culmination of the 2025 academic year, as mandated by the state of North Dakota, students in grades 3, 4, and 5 are expected to elevate their proficiency levels on the Math summative assessment from 18% to 24%.



Smart Goal 3: SEL

Increase the percentage of students receiving SEL & culturally relevant services by 5% from Fall of 2024 to Spring of 2025, transitioning from Tier III/Tier II to Tier II/Tier I.



Smart Goal 4: Attendance

Based on the Federal Chronic Absenteeism report from NASIS the percentage of students with chronic and severe chronic absenteeism will decrease from 39% to 34 % by the end of the 2024-25 school year.
