This is one reason we have continued to offer a Preschool calendar this year to include more days and longer periods of time for our youngest students. Parents and staff are surveyed on a yearly basis. Our needs assessment consists of examination of all assessment data, using staff development days to study and addressing areas of concern meeting with the principals to discuss and continuously revisit student progress during Child Study Team meetings. Our increased use of technology through the use of iPads in grades PK-5 and a 1:1 iPad program with students in grades 6-12 increase the availability of researched based programs for all students to use specific to their individual needs.
