Exit of Targeted School Improvement Status(TSI)

Our school was notified that we met the criteria of exiting Targeted Support and Improvement status within the required timeline!

Our exit was highly influenced by our intense increase of Choice Ready Graduates! TMCHS increased this percentage by 19%

What we are doing to continually address this?

- Continued implementation of the Multi-Tiered Support System to assist students in ELA and Math to bring all learners to grade level.
- Incorporation of Restorative Practices for discipline including the 7 Teachings as a foundation for behavior
- Increased student engagement and teacher training to support engagement in the classroom.



MTSS-Multi Tiered System of Support



MTSS is system used at the school to help all students reach their full potential by instructing them at the appropriate level for them to learn best. The <u>High School Academic Guide</u> shows the parts of the process.

It involves three levels:

Tier 1 - This is the level that all grade level instruction takes place.

Tier 2 - This is where students who have some areas of weakness receive extra support in the area needed.

Tier 3 - This is where students more than 2 grade levels behind their peers get instruction to build their foundational skills by providing more individualized and intensive instruction. Please see the MTSS Parent Information Chart for more detailed information.
