Туре	Explanation
Excused Absence	<ul> <li>Students are allotted 10 days of excused absences per school year. Any absences beyond the 10 days will be classified as unexcused absences (truancies) unless the absences qualify to be exempt absences. Once a student accrues 5 days of excused absences, a letter is mailed home as a notification/warning that the student has utilized half of their allotted days. Once a student accrues 10 days of excused absences, a second letter is mailed home notifying the student and family that all future absences will be recorded as unexcused absences (truancies) unless the absences qualify to be exempt absences.</li> <li>Examples include, but are not limited to: funeral, vacation, medical/dental appointment without a medical/dental note, general illness or injury, and special event (not school-sponsored).</li> <li>Parent/Guardian reports absence to the attendance office. These absences DO count towards the 10 days of excused absences allotted per school year.</li> </ul>
Exempt Absence	<ul> <li>Examples include, but are not limited to: school-sponsored activity, field trip, and medical/dental appointment with a medical/dental note.</li> <li>For a medical/dental appointment, a student submits a medical/dental note to the attendance office. These absences <u>DO NOT</u> count towards the 10 days of excused absences allotted per school year.</li> </ul>
Unexcused Absence (Truancy)	<ul> <li>Reasons for an unexcused absence (truancy): <ul> <li>Parent/Guardian does not report absence to the attendance office in advance.</li> <li>The unexcused absence will convert to a truancy in 2 school days if a parent/guardian does not communicate an acceptable reason for the absence.</li> <li>If a parent/guardian does communicate an acceptable reason for the absence within 2 school days (and the student has not accrued 10 days of excused absences) the absence will convert to an excused absence.</li> <li>Student is late to/misses any class without an approved excuse. Students will be marked unexcused absence if their absence is not reported and they arrive after the first period.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Students who are truant from school for all or part of 5 or more school days in a given semester are considered to be habitual truants. A habitual truancy letter is mailed home which includes details for a follow up meeting with school personnel.</li> </ul>
Tardy Excused	Student arrives after the bell, but before the end of the first period, and a parent/guardian reports the tardy to the attendance office with an acceptable reason.
Tardy Unexcused	Student arrives after the bell, and attends a majority of the period, and a parent/guardian does not report the tardy to the attendance office or a parent/guardian does report the tardy with an unacceptable reason.
Other Information	<ul> <li>To be marked present and on time to first period, students must be through the doors of their scheduled class by 7:30am.</li> <li>All students entering the building between 7:30am-2:45pm must enter through the main entrance and check in with a member of the front office staff before proceeding to class.</li> <li>Templeton Middle School is a closed campus. Students must stay in the building from the time they arrive until dismissal.</li> <li>Per the Student Handbook, to participate in an athletic or co-curricular contest or practice, a student must attend school on the day of the contest or practice, and not have been in an after school detention or an in-school suspension during that day. The only exception would be an excused absence, approved in advance by the coach, athletic directors or administrator.</li> <li>If the activity or contest is on a Saturday, the student must be in school the day before.</li> </ul>
