Your Written Reflection

Your written response should be in paragraph format, with accurate, detailed supporting evidence.

Paragraph 1 should include concrete detail and commentary about

- how the climate and vegetation of the region influence this traditional African dish
- why this African dish is made by people in this country

Paragraph 2 should include concrete detail and commentary about

- what ingredients were used to make this traditional African dish
- why you chose to make this particular African dish

Concrete Details (C.D.) and Commentary (C) - Expand upon your topic sentence. How are these ingredients produced in your country? Are they grown(plants), raised (animals), or traded/bought (spices)?
