## "Coyote and Buffalo" (p.38-40)

- 1. How does Coyote use magic to avoid Buffalo's attack?
- 2. What human characteristics does Buffalo Bull show in this story?
- 3. Beside Coyote, who else is a trickster in this story? What lesson does this teach?
- 4. What natural phenomenon does this trickster tale help to explain? How is it explained in the story?
- 5. Based on this tale, what traits are admired in **Okanogan** society? What traits are scorned? Explain. *Consider the following in your response: What actions are rewarded? What actions are punished?*

## "Fox and Coyote and Whale" (p. 41-43)

- 1. What is the central conflict of this story? *Hint: it is introduced in the first paragraph*.
- 2. Identify reasons why Coyote and Fox are considered "twins" in the story.
- 3. When Fox breaks the water maidens' necks, what does this action say about Fox and tricksters? Explain.
- 4. What natural phenomenon does this trickster tale help to explain? How is it explained in the story?
- 5. Identify and contrast the tone of this story with "Coyote and Buffalo".
