Clearly different



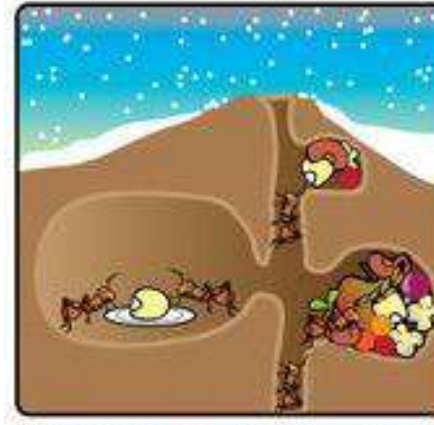

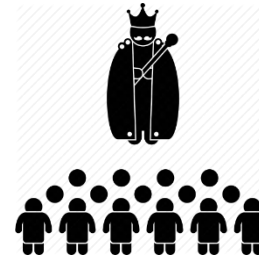

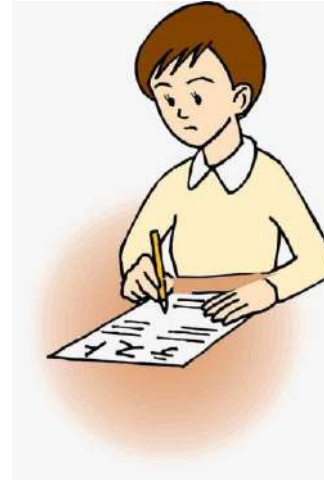
