Triptych Funny Self-Portraits Black & White









Study the images shared here and understand what makes each uniquely funny. <u>Adde Adesokan</u> is a contemporary photographer who really gets some great images of his subjects. Look him up online.

Go <u>outside</u> and photograph a few different images of yourself from the perspective you'd like. I suggest that you move your camera angles up and down as needed. Do different poses, use props and fun facial expressions! Remember to not have any distractions in the background that may take away from your portrait idea.

In the end, you will crop down and piece each of your images together in photoshop. I would suggest you make your final image a 12x18x150 and put your images on this background. You can make your background any color you want. But the final images will be in full black and white. Make sure you adjust the level correctly and dodge and burn as needed. The last step is to find and download a signature font from online to your photoshop fonts and sign the lower right corner of your bottom image.

Image 1: As you shoot, keep in mind that the first image is an eye level image of the face. What are you doing to make your face interesting or unique?

Image 2: Again, the eye level of the camera should be straight on! This one is the best one to make your image different and creative. What are you doing with your hands?

Image 3: Eye level! Get down low for this shot. What is cool and different for your shot?

Now put it all together!
