Twirly Ball

Equipment:

2 Laundry Baskets

7 inch Gopher ball

Baskets are ~20 feet apart. Each team takes turns trying to score points by hitting or ringing the basket.

First the non-throwing teammate spins the basket. The throwing player must throw the ball before the basket stops spinning.

- 1 point is scored if the thrower hits the basket
- 2 points are scored if the ball lands in the basket
- 3 points are scored if the ball stays in the basket

Rules

- Four players are involved in the game. Two players on each team
- When in play, the players must remain behind the goal at all times. Do not pass the line in front of the goal!
- No points are given to a player if your ball has been thrown and has hit the ground before hitting the goal.
- No points are given if the partner of the thrower (deflector) catches, carries or double deflects the ball into the goal
- Three points are given if the opposing team try to deflect a goal or interfere in any way if the team playing are winning
- To win you must reach an exact score of twenty one, but if you go over twenty one then your points will be deducted until you go back to twenty one, eg, you have scored twenty two then played again and scored one, you are a winner because the one point was deducted for going over
- A team must have the same number of turns for the game to end unless you have an 'instant win'
- If you have a tie then each team will have a game to break the tie. The team with the most points wins.
