Union County Principal's and Assistant Principal's Association Scholarship Program 2017

The Union County Principal's and Assistant Principal's Association (UCPAPA) has established and funded one (1) \$1,000.00 scholarship to be awarded each year. UCPAPA believes that this financial encouragement to a young person in Union County Schools will promote and perpetuate the educational process.

The Scholarship Program will be administered according to the following guidelines:

- UCPAPA will administer this scholarship by utilizing a scholarship committee, which will consist of at least 3 members of the
 association. The President of UCPAPA shall appoint the Scholarship Committee each year that a scholarship is to be
 awarded.
- 2. The scholarship will be awarded for \$1,000.00 and shall be payable to the recipient and the college that the recipient is planning to attend. The recipient will present a college invoice to the President of UCPAPA, and the Treasurer will write a joint check to the recipient and the college. The \$1,000.00 scholarship will be a one-time payment.
- 3. Scholarship recipients must have been a permanent resident of Union County six months prior to making application for this scholarship. The Scholarship recipient must have been enrolled in one of the Union County High Schools for a minimum of one (1) semester when applying for this scholarship. Only seniors in Union County High Schools are eligible for this scholarship.
- 4. Scholarship recipients must enroll as a full-time college student in a four-year college or university in the fall semester following the award of the UCPAPA Scholarship.
- 5. The recipient of the scholarship must:
 - a. Plan to major in education / teaching
 - b. Have a minimum GPA of 2.0
 - c. Exhibit leadership qualities based on grades and extra-curricular activities
 - d. Present three letters of character recommendation (one from a former teacher, one from an employer/supervisor/coach, and one from a person of the applicant's choosing
- 6. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to interview all candidates or only the three finalists, at the committee's discretion.
- 7. The Scholarship recipient will be notified of his/her selection by the President of UCPAPA and will be recognized during the student's school awards program or as the school's administration sees fit.
- 8. UCPAPA does not practice discrimination against applicants on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, age or handicap.
- 9. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is solely the committee's discretion, and the decision is final.
