1. GAIVNET:

Second-hand clothing with a sense of history.

2. BATWINDAS:

A strip of fabric attached at the waistline edge of the garment and is visible above the waistline.

3. TVANA - DEARG:

Fashions that are innovative, extreme, and daring.

4. HASFNIO CECYL:

The periodic return of specific styles and general shapes.

5. LSCASIC:

A style that stays in fashion for a long time.

6. GLARNA VELESE:

A sleeve with diagonal seams in the front and back that extend from the neck to under the arms.

7. ADF:

Something new in clothing that quickly becomes popular, but only for a short time.

8. HIFANOS:

A particular style of apparel that is popular at a given time.

9. PLEARPA:

All men's, women's, and children's clothing.

10. RETSDTERNET:

A person who takes the lead or sets an example.

11. ARDT:

A stitched fold that provides shape and fullness to a garment so it fits the curve of the body.

12. TYLSE:

A particular design, shape, or type of garment or apparel item.

13. TSE-NI-ELEVSE:

A sleeve attached to the body of the garment with a seam that circles the armhole near the shoulder.

14. TROER:

Clothing that resembles styles from at least 20 years ago.

15. OIMNKNO ELVESE:

A sleeve that is a seamless extension of the garment's front and back.

16. SHIAFON NTDRE:

The direction in which a particular change or fashion is moving.
