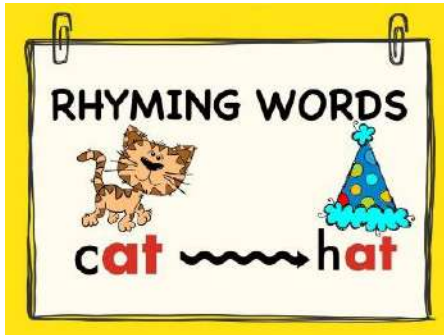




sweet

to make a circle around



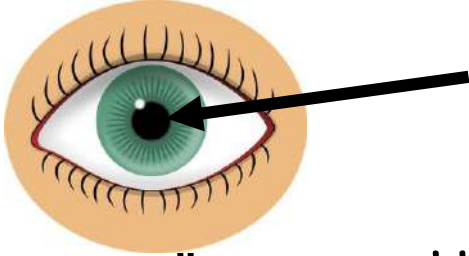
frightened

bragging



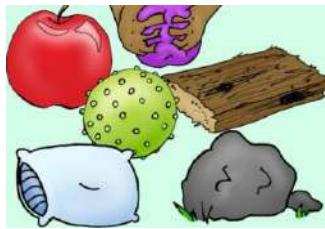
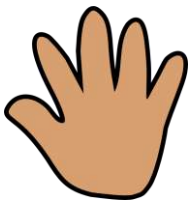
pupil

a small, covered black hole in the center of the eye where light enters



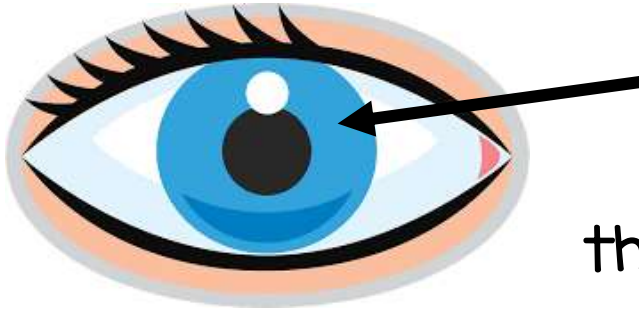
scents
