Spelling Generalization/Rule (Vowel Diphthongs)

Sometimes the letters *ou* and *ow* stand for the diphthong */ou/*. The letters *oi* and *oy* stand for the diphthong */oi/*. In a diphthong, each vowel contributes to the sound heard.
