- Population, wealth, and industrial production

Review

What was a major factor in the shift in American foreign policy toward imperialism in the late 19th century?

- The need for overseas markets for increased industrial and agricultural production

The numerous near-wars and diplomatic crises of the United States in the late 1880s and 1890s demonstrated what:

- The aggressive new national mood

Review

Why was Hawaii's Queen Liliuokalani removed from power?

- Queen Lil' opposed annexation to the United States and insisted that Native Hawaiians should continue to control Hawaii.

Before a treaty annexing Hawaii to the United States could be rushed through the US Senate in 1893, what happened?

- President Harrison's term expired and anti-imperialist, President Grover Cleveland became president.

Review

In an attempt to persuade Spain to leave Cuba or to encourage the United States to help Cuba to gain its' independence, what did Cuban *insurrectos* do?

- Burned the corn fields and sugar mills
- 'scorched earth' policy- they believed that no one would want burned unusable land

Review

Who sunk the battleship *Maine*?

- It was sunken by an explosion on the ship

Why did President William McKinley ask Congress to declare war on Spain?

- Because of yellow journalism and the sinking of the *Maine*, the American people demanded it

Where did most American military during the Spanish-American War come from?

- America's new steel navy

Review

Who was the Philippine nationalist who led the insurrection against both Spanish rule and the later United States occupation?

- Emilio Aguinaldo

Review

What happened when the United States invaded Puerto Rico during the Spanish-American War?

- Most of the population greeted the invaders as liberating heroes

What did American imperialists who advocated acquisition of the Philippine Islands?

- They stressed their economic potential for American businessmen seeking trade with China and other Asian nations.

What amendment gave the United States a virtual right to intervention in Cuba?

- The Platt Amendment

The Roosevelt Corollary called for what?

- It added a new provision to the Monroe Doctrine, it would justify U.S. interventionism in the affairs of Latin America

What was an immediate cause of the Spanish-American war?

- The explosion and sinking of the battleship *U.S.S. Maine*

What type of influence did yellow journalism have on U.S. foreign policy in the 1890s? Why?

- Their news stories stirred the anger of the American public

What was Theodore Roosevelt's policy on the Panama Canal?

- Roosevelt gave military support to Panama's revolt against Colombia

- It assumed rule over millions of Asian people
