Unit 1: Proper Breathing Technique for Wind Players

Essential Understandings	Instrumental music requires basic breathing skills and proper techniques.
Essential Questions	- What is proper playing posture? - What is meant by “diaphragm” breathing? - What is proper tone production?
Essential Knowledge	- Wind tone production begins with good posture. - Use of the diaphragm muscle is needed for proper air pressure. - Use of firm air pressure is important at all volumes.
Vocabulary	<u>Terms:</u> - posture, tone production, “hissing air”, diaphragm
Essential Skills	- Demonstrate proper body/instrument position. - Maintain even flow at most dynamic levels. - Hold long tones with an evenness of tone.
