### Spelling Generalization/Rule:

Prefixes: When the prefixes *un-*, *mis-*, or *dis-* are added to words they change the meaning of the word. *unhappy*, *recall*, *mistake*, *dislike*. Adding certain prefixes to base words does not usually change the pronunciation of the base word.

un- means "not" or "do the opposite of"  
re- means "again"  
mis- means "bad" or "badly"  
dis- means "not," "lack of," or the "opposite of"

Prefixes usually form separate syllables from the base word.
