	At some point, Pangaea broke apart and the pieces slowly moved apart over a long period of time.	<div style="border: 1px dashed black; width: 100%; height: 100%;"></div>	
	Tectonic plates move very slowly due to the heat and pressure in Earth's mantle.	<div style="border: 1px dashed black; width: 100%; height: 100%;"></div>	
	Material in the mantle moves beneath stuck rocks at a fault, causing pressure to build over time and then suddenly release as the rocks break and slip past each other, shaking the ground.	<div style="border: 1px dashed black; width: 100%; height: 100%;"></div>
