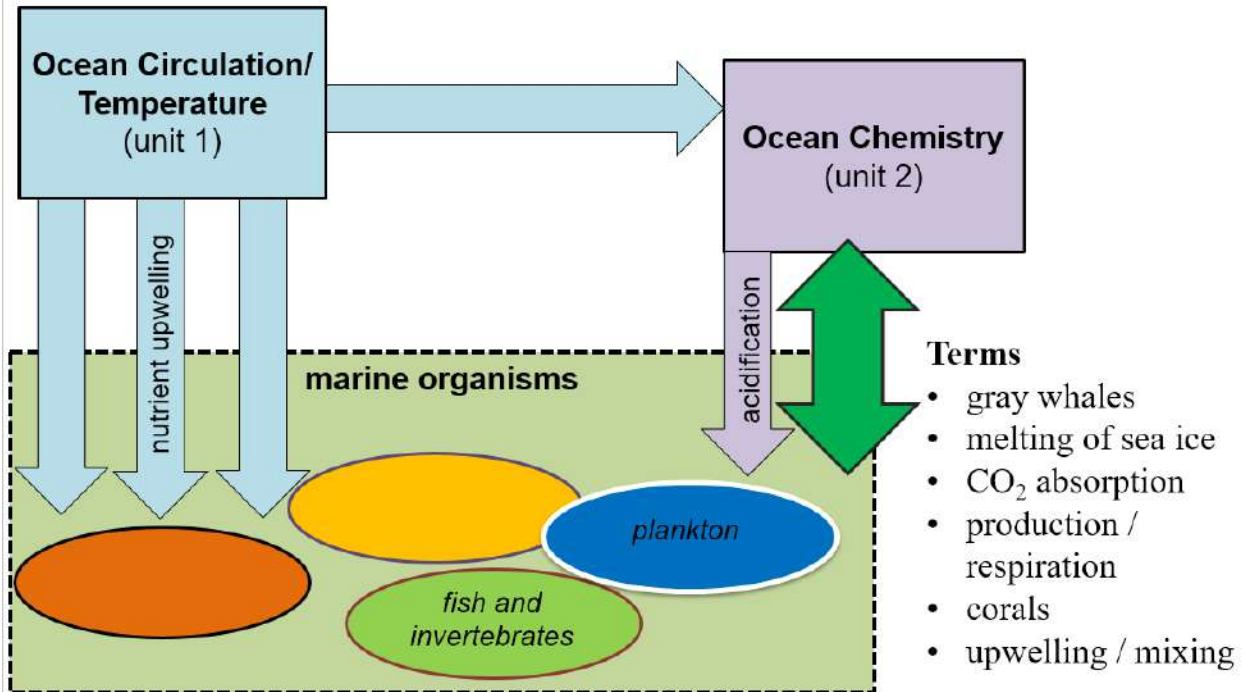


Review of examples on how temperature and carbon concentration may interact and affect organisms

Definitions:

Plankton – marine organisms that “drift in the ocean”; for example: algae or shrimp

Invertebrate – animal lacking a backbone; for example: mussels or crabs
