

# Portland Oregon

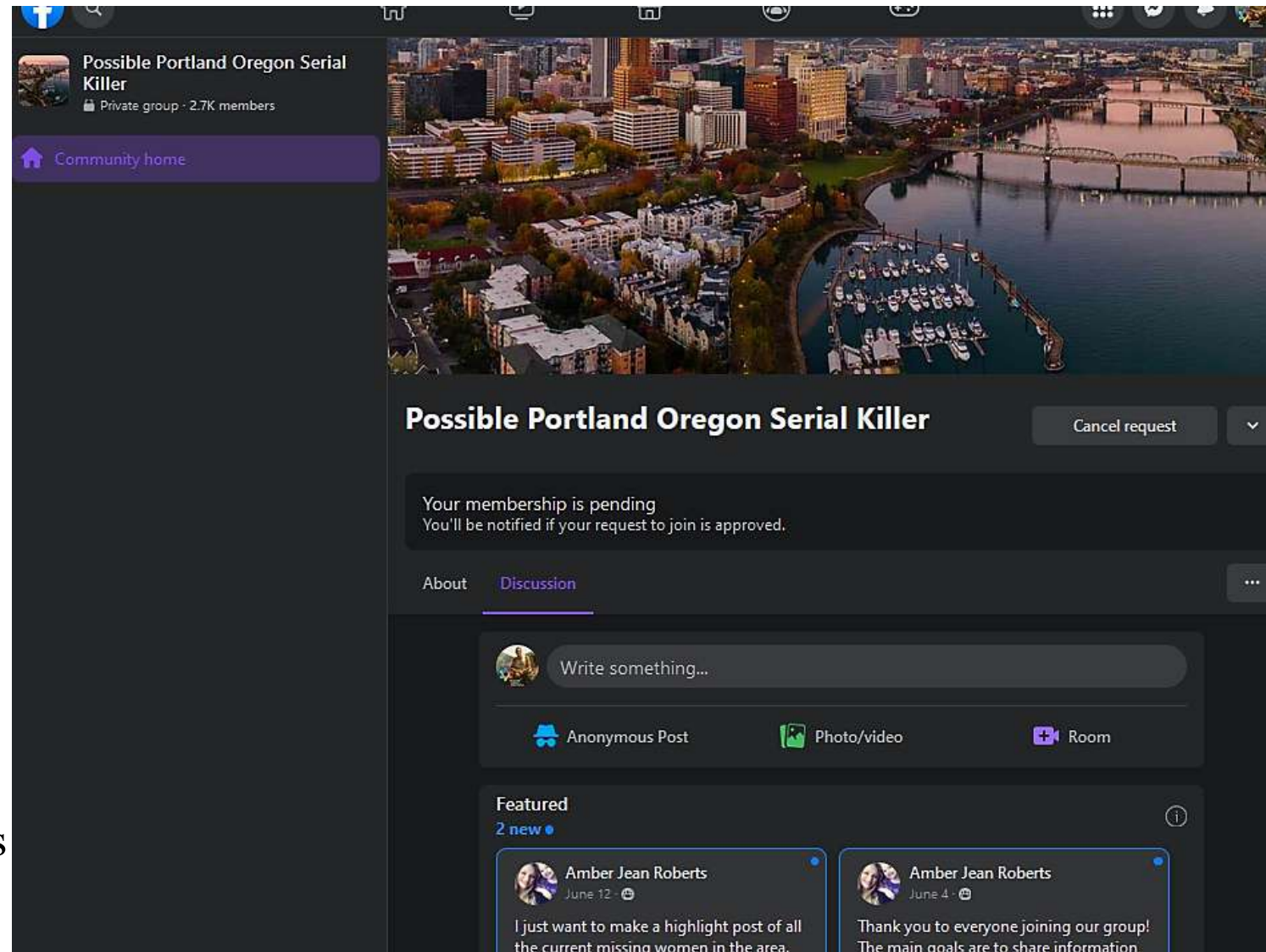
Six women – most with connections to greater Portland area and all under age 40 – have been found dead within 100 miles of one another over three months in early 2023, most in wooded or secluded rural areas.

Are they connected?

Oregon has the 10<sup>th</sup> most missing persons (401), even though it ranks 27<sup>th</sup> in population size

Multnomah County:  
46 missing women/girls in all of 2022. Already 71 through the first half of 2023

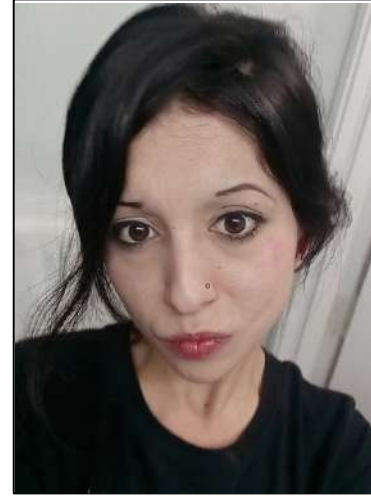
○Note: some of the disappearances may be linked to Oregon's policies on homelessness and open-air drug use





Kristin Smith (Reedus)

- Age 22, 5'2", visible tattoo
- Wears different wigs
- Missing November 19, found February 19
- Body found in wooded area near Pleasant Valley



Ashley Real

- Age 22, 4'11, visible tattoo
- Hispanic
- Missing March 27, found May 1.
- Last seen at McDonalds on Division St



Joanna Speaks age 32

- 2013, plead guilty of attempted robbery and attempted murder of Oregon man (served 3 years)
- 3 kids, ages 13, 12, 7
- Missing March, found April 8
- Died of blunt head and neck injuries
- Believed body was moved to location where it was found



Unidentified woman

- Aged 25-40
  - Native American or Native Alaskan,
  - about 5'; tattoos (visible?)
  - Found April 24, near interstate 205
- Later said to not be suspicious*



Charity Lynn Perry age 24

- Involved in drugs. Accused dad and uncle of something.
- She was frequently seen near downtown Portland at the beginning of March, near an area where a major drug center was broken up by police.
- Found April 24
- Schizophrenic



Bridget Ramsey Webster

- Age 31
- Lived in Milwaukie
- Missing: Found April 30
- "Suspicious death"

17 July 2023

**Suspect** Jesse Lee Calhoun age 38 (July 2023)

- Felony convictions date back to 2005 (age 19)
- prolific theft, career criminality, drugs (meth), felony in possession of firearms, assault (2003, 2008) and strangulation.
- In 2022 he lived in Southeast Portland, in 2019 in Wood Village and Troutdale (with family). Worked as a self-employed car detailer. “has two teenage kids and used meth daily”
- November 2019 – multiple felonies, including burglary, unauthorized possession of a stolen vehicle, injuring a police officer and police dog while evading arrest. Sentenced to 4 years, 2 months
- 22 July 2021 – he is among 1,000 inmates granted clemency by Governor Kate Brown for fighting wildfires. He was released 11 months early.
- 6 July 2023 – Clemency was revoked (the same day authorities asked the new Governor to do so).
- When police approached him, he tried to escape by jumping into the Willamette River. Apprehended for “parole violations”
  - Connection to victims: on-and-off relationship with Ashley, and gave drugs/food-for-sex to Bridget
  - Ashley reported to police in November 2022 that suspect tried to strangle her; found dead in May 2023.
