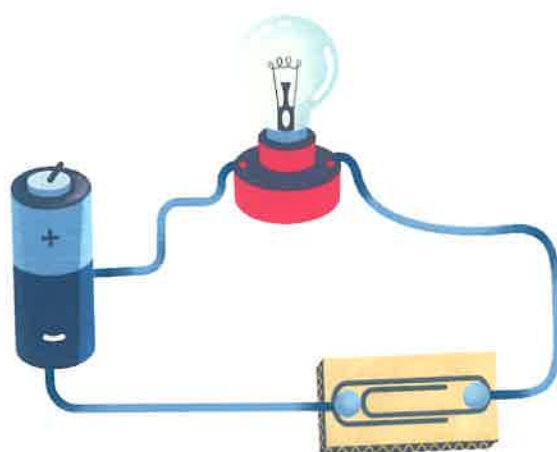

Drivers Education Classes

Plans for Summer 2024 Drivers Education classes are being made at this time. In order for students to qualify for Drivers Education they **must be at least 14 years of age and have a valid instructional permit by May 10**. If there is a need to limit enrollment, the in-district students will have priority. The class list will start with the oldest students first. All students enrolled in Dunkerton Community Schools **or living within the district boundary lines attending private or parochial schools or home schooled are considered in-district**.

The parent and student meeting will be held on May 15, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. The class start date for the **Summer session** will be on May 15, 2024 (same night). Students need to bring chromebook and calendar of events) **Maximum enrollment for Summer session is 30**.

Deadline for the Summer session is May 10, 2024. The driver education fees are as follows: out-of-district students \$350.00; in-district students \$300.00 (for in-district students this fee may be reduced by completing a waiver of fees form, if your family has not completed one this school year). All fee waiver requests and fees must be included when the registration form is returned. All fees are non-refundable without board approval. Checks must be made payable to Dunkerton Community Schools and will be deposited upon receipt. Complete and return the following form to the **highschool office** along with your registration check/cash, waiver sheet and permit. **There is an additional \$25 late fee if you are past the session deadline**.

In order to register, the following form must be completed and be accompanied with the payment.

The driver education completion certificate will be online and accessed by the Department of Transportation in order for the student to get her/his license. In order to be registered for this class, the following form must be completed, along with the payment and a copy of the driver's permit.

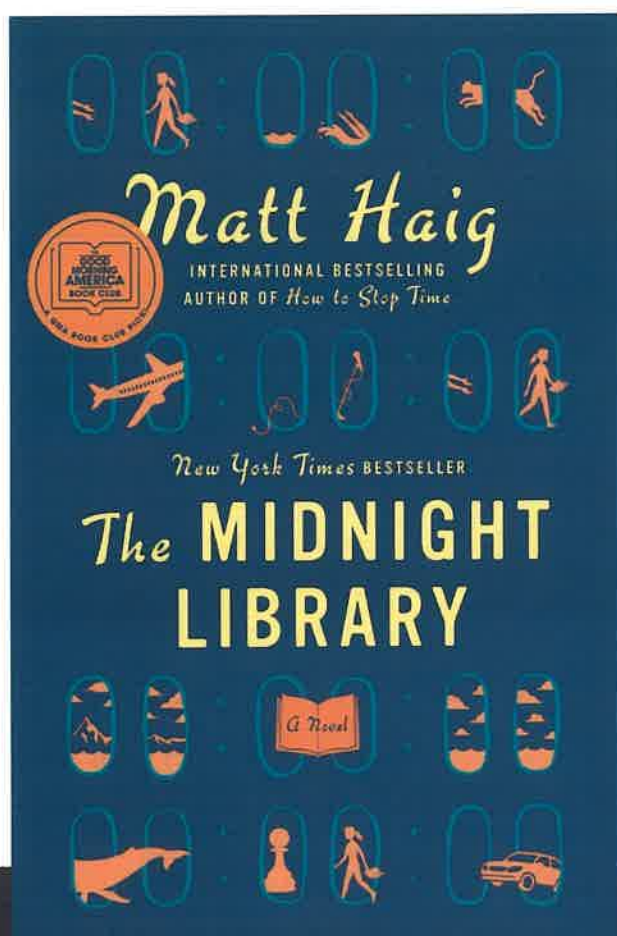


