

## **BLACK AND WHITE PICTURE CONTINUATION**

- 1. Find a black and white photo, cut a 2"x2" section of it out. IMMEDIATELY throw away the unused/other part. (1pt)**
- 2. Using one small piece of rolled tape, tape the photo section on the center and slightly to the left or right side of the scratch paper.**
- 3. On the Manila/Scratch paper, sketch out ideas on how you would complete the original piece of artwork on all 4 sides. (4pts)**
- 4. Be sure that each side connects and is related to the photo section. (4pts)**
- 5. Get sketches approved by your teacher before starting the final. (1pt)**
- 6. Using one small piece of rolled tape, tape the photo section on final paper.**
- 7. On the white paper, sketch out your final picture. (1pt)**
- 8. Be sure that the positive and negative spaces are balanced. ADD DETAILS (2pts)**
- 9. Using a variety of values to shade with Shade your sketch accurately. (minimum of 6). (6 pts). MATCH VALUES AND PROPORTIONS to the picture. (8 pts)**
- 10. Be original and creative; think about your Composition (6pts)**
- 11. Final step: Glue the photo section onto your finished original work of art. (1pt)**
