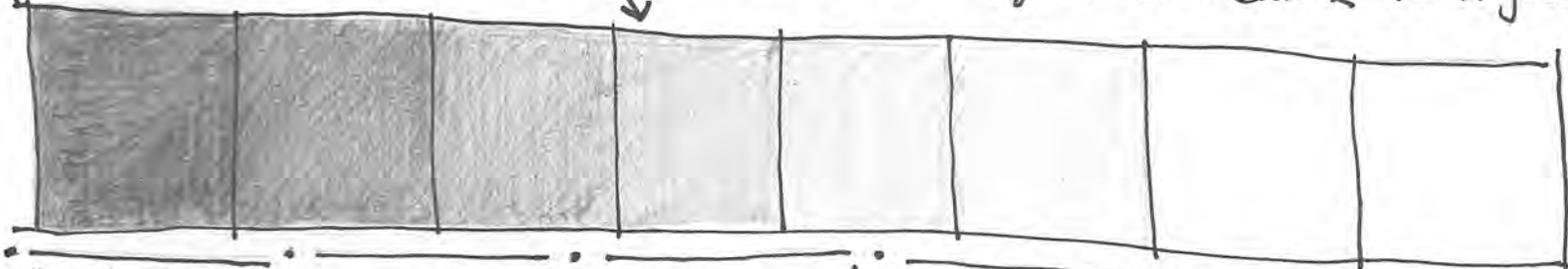


VALUE

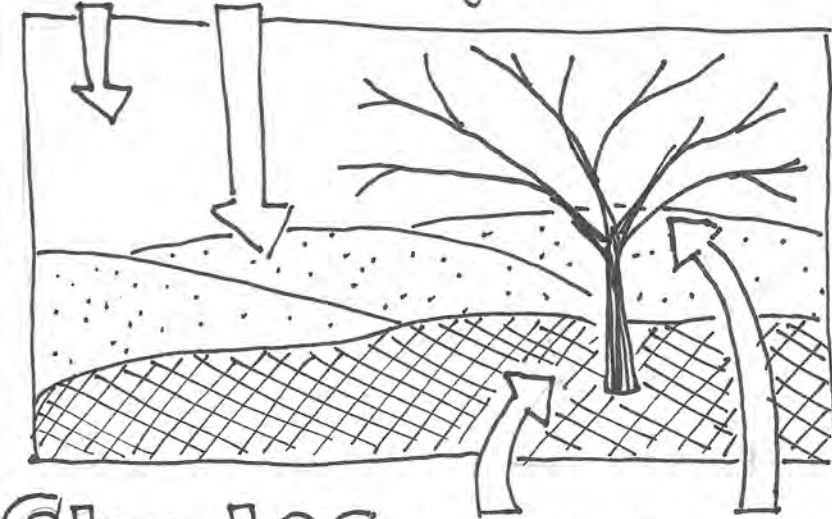
elements of art

value is the lightness or darkness of a color

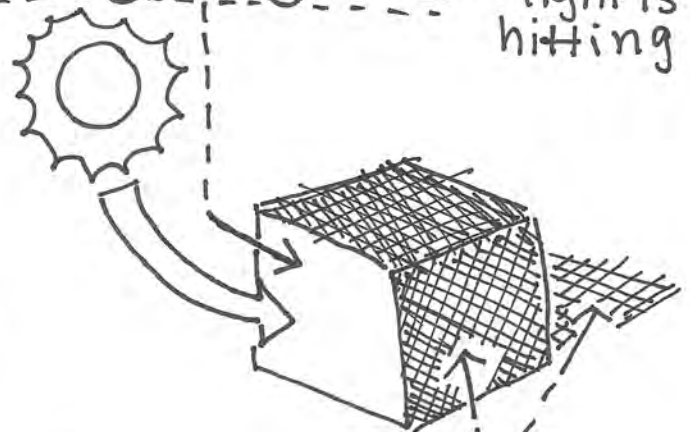
VALUE SCALE: shows the range from dark to light



+ tint + the light values



highlights where the light is hitting



Shades the dark values

Shadows where the light is not hitting

different ways to shade:

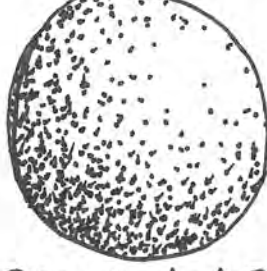
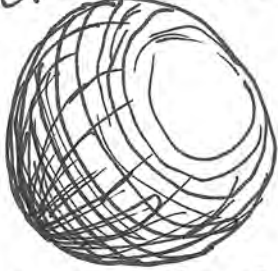
HATCHING

CROSS HATCH

STIPPLING

CIRCULAR

BLENDING



Parallel lines crossed lines small dots scribbles
Place lines, dots, and scribbles close together to create shadows; spread them out for highlights.

An area shaded in, then blended out to the light area.

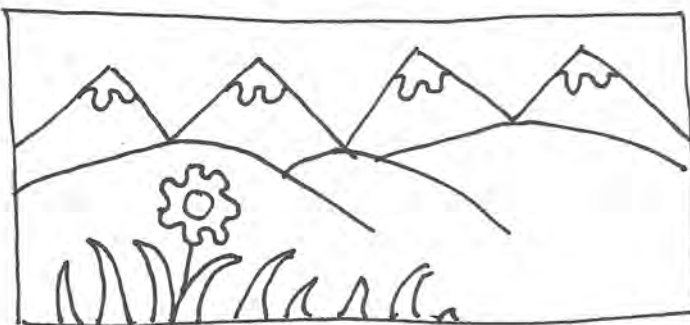
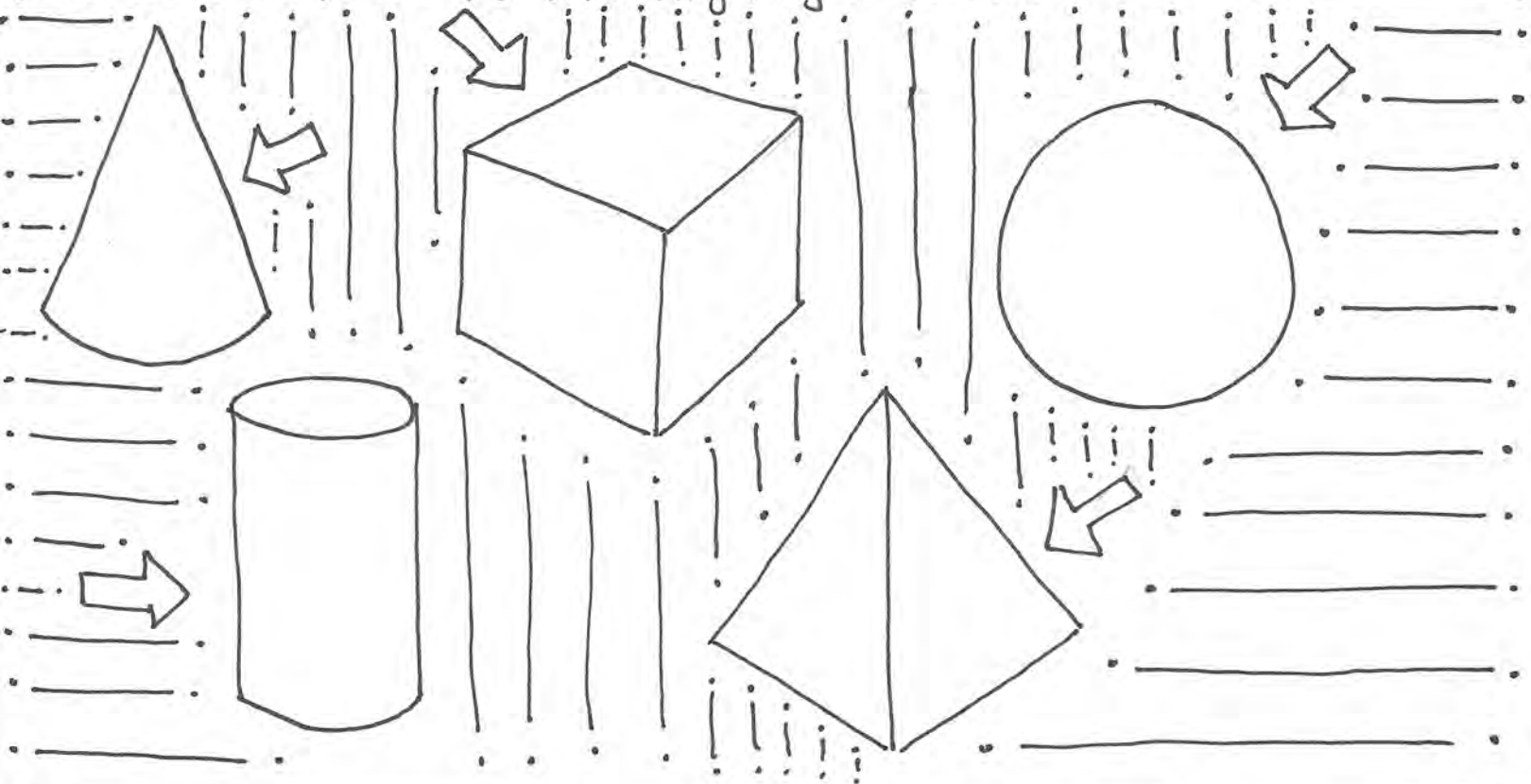
