3. A short essay which indicates the way he/she has practiced good citizenship through volunteerism. Please make sure that your essay reflects your interest by using correct grammar and punctuation.
4. Brief letter of support from the individual who supervised the student's volunteerism.

Please return the completed application to the VHS Guidance Counselor's Office by April 15, 2022. Applications received after that date will not be considered.
