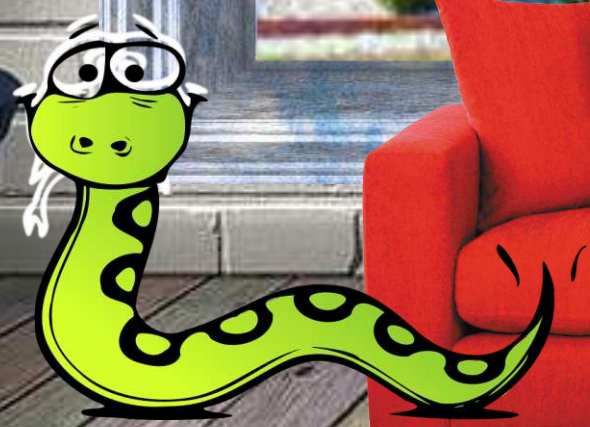
Morehouse College
