

Our Visual Arts program develops innovative students with world-ready experience and meaningful industry expertise.



➤ **Discover your passion and find your purpose at Ponaganset** in the classroom, in student organizations, and experiential learning opportunities. The Visual Arts program offers hands-on, relevant, and rigorous instruction to students interested in pursuing art related careers.

➤ **Immerse yourself in real-world learning experiences** and earn 80 work-based learning hours. Students must complete 80 hours during their four years. These hours are earned through industry projects, service learning, internships, and community based partnerships.
