## ▶ **EARLY CHILDHOOD FAMILY EDUCATION** (ages birth to kindergarten and parents)

- » ECFE is a family education program for all parents and their children providing classes and special events. ## ▶ **WACONIA WILDCAT PRESCHOOL / WACONIA FAMILY PRESCHOOL** (ages 3 - 5 years old)

- » Waconia Wildcat Preschool promotes social, emotional, and cognitive skills through interactive curriculum. By providing a nurturing and stimulating environment, Wildcat Preschool fosters healthy relationships between parents and their children, as well as students and their peers.
- » Waconia Family Preschool provides families the opportunity for interactive learning, most notably with parent and child play time. This high-quality preschool partnership supports parents through education and collaboration.

## ▶ **KIDS' COMPANY** (PreK - grade 5)
