Waddell Language Academy Replacement Facility as Part of CMS' Planned 2017 Bond

Current Facility

- Waddell Language Academy is a premier language immersion program, which CMS is committed to maintaining at its current level of theme fidelity and quality
- Programs offered
 - o 2 sections per grade level in K-5 for German, French and Chinese Immersion
 - o 1 section per grade level in K-5 for Japanese Immersion
 - Immersion continuation grades 6-8
 - The addition of Spanish at grades 6-8
- Waddell uses 71 classrooms today to support its K-8 program
 - 42 for elementary classroom instruction
 - o 21 for middle grades core instruction (e.g., English/Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Science)
 - 8 for specials (not including the 2 gyms and media center)

Plan for K-8 Replacement Facility

- The new facility planned for Waddell Language Immersion as part of the 2017 bond includes a total of 63 classrooms, 9 of which can be used flexibly according to the school's program offering
 - o 54 classrooms
 - 3 science labs
 - 2 classrooms for specials (flexible)
 - 2 art rooms (flexible)
 - 2 digital learning rooms (flexible)
 - 1 dance / theater room (flexible)
 - 2 music rooms (flexible)
- The new facility also includes
 - o Cafeteria
 - Media center
 - o Gym
 - Multi-purpose space

The difference in the number of classrooms spaces between the current Waddell facility and the planned Waddell facility is 8 classrooms.

Working with a cross-functional team which includes the principal, Dr. Eybl, we are confident the difference in the number of classrooms can be accounted for <u>without</u> eliminating any languages currently offered at the school and without reducing the number of sections offered per language.

Approaches to accounting for the 8 classroom difference may include but are not limited to:

- Leveraging the new facility's "flexible" spaces to more creatively use space and enhance specials offerings
- Examining and eliminating current underutilization of classroom spaces (e.g., using all classrooms all periods of the day, matching class size / use to space capacity, etc.)
