Required Materials:

2. All laboratory activities will be conducted and stored in class.
3. One missing lab will be dropped per quarter including labs missed from absences.

Tests: (approximately 60%)

Will be given approximately every 1-2 weeks at the end of a unit. Tests will always be announced ahead of time and posted on my website's calendar. **Science testing days are days 1, 3, 4, & 6**

Extra Help:

Will be offered routinely based on when a unit is coming to a close. Extra help will be held in my classroom after school (2:25). This will always be posted on my website's calendar under the tests links. Students may also see me for additional extra help upon their request.

Grades:

Your quarterly grades will be determined by your performance on homework assignments, lab reports, projects, and tests. Tests will always count the most toward your overall grade. The effort you put into your homework, labs, projects, should boost your test average unless you fail to put effort into these assignments.
