

# **Student Recognitions and Accomplishments**

### WHS WIND ENSEMBLE

Our WHS Wind Ensemble recently participated in MPA and received an *Excellent Rating* on stage and a *Superior Rating* in sight reading! They were really challenged this year with some very difficult literature. We are very proud of their performance as they made truly beautiful music at this prestigious event.

### <u>FFA</u>

Our FFA (Future Farmers of America) student group recently organized and facilitated a very special event which showcased the different FFA chapters of our UCPS high schools. The highlight of the evening was a message on leadership delivered by the North Carolina Commissioner of Agriculture, Mr. Steve Troxler. Kudos to our FFA students, under the direction of Mr. Andy Nelson, for their meticulous planning and hard work to put on such a professional showcase of our FFA club and Weddington High School.

### <u>JROTC</u>

The male and female MCJROTC athletic teams both placed first in Region 2 in the National Youth Physical Fitness (NYPFT) Competition. Region 2 consist of NC, SC, TN, GA, FL and AL. The male team won by 353 points for their second straight championship, and the females won by 228 points for their third consecutive championship. The NYPFT consists of pull-ups, crunches, push-ups, stand and broad jump, and a 300 yard shuttle run. The teams consist of six members, and the top five scores count toward the competition. On Thursday, April 11, the Arrive Alive experience was at Weddington High School.
