Parent Survey Results

We recently deployed a survey to parents with the objective to gather feedback data related to the perceptions that the parents of WHS students have of our guidance counselors. The survey focused on three main areas: responsiveness, demeanor, and helpfulness. We had a relatively low number of survey participants, but we still believe that the data provides us with valuable information that we will use to drive improvement. In summary, we are *pleased with perceptions on counselor <u>demeanor</u>, feel "ok" about perceptions on counselor <u>helpfulness</u>, and identify <u>counselor responsiveness</u> as a key area for improvement. We were also able to breakdown the data by each individual counselor and have shared the individualized feedback data with each of them. Thanks to those of you who participated. We assure you that the data will be used to drive improvement efforts.*

Report Card Distribution Date Change

Please see the note below from our principal which was sent our earlier this week.

WHS Families,

The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) announced last week that there are errors occurring in the software that all North Carolina school districts use to report student grades. NCDPI and PowerSchool identified a malfunction with the grade calculation function currently used by PowerTeacher Pro.

Union County Public Schools is currently assessing all students' grades to determine if there has been any impact on grades in our school system. Be assured that the grades your son or daughter received up to now will not be negatively impacted by the new calculations.

As a result, UCPS is changing the report card distribution date from January 31 to February 7, 2019.
