Absences and Teacher Made Final Exam Exemptions

Absences have an impact on whether or not a student can be exempt from a teacher made final exam. The follow excerpt outlines the requirements for teacher made final exam exemptions as is found on page 24 of the 2022-2023 UCPS High School Student Handbook which can be accessed by clicking HERE.

High School students will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:

- The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 2 unexcused absences in the class; or
- The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 1 unexcused absence in the class.

IMPORTANT ATTENDANCE REMINDER

As a friendly reminder, up to 5 days can be excused with a parent-written attendance note and it can only be accepted within the current 6-week grading period. A physician note will be accepted at any time. Always be sure the student's full name and date of visit is clearly stated. 

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL REMINDERS






