PreACT TESTING FOR SOPHOMORES

All sophomores will participate in PreACT testing on **Friday, March 26th**.

- **Only 10th graders (Plan B and D students) will attend school on Friday, March 26th to participate in the PreACT. *All other grades will work remotely on Friday, March 26th.***
- Buses will run for sophomores that day.
- In order to ensure small groups with proper social distancing in a secure testing environment, teachers will be administering the exams all day.
- All 9th, 11th, and 12th grade students will have assignments to be completed remotely that day.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING PREACT EXAM ADMINISTRATION WILL BE SHARED WITH SOPHOMORES IN THE WEEKS PRIOR TO THE EXAM.

The PreACT is designed to help students predict their future scores on the ACT after an additional year of learning. Students can use their scores to make an academic learning plan to help reach their desired ACT score.

Any student with prior approved testing accommodations will receive their accommodations on test day for PreACT. However, please note that when taking the ACT or SAT, students must apply to receive approved accommodations for testing. Mrs. Washington works with both organizations to apply for student accommodations.

The PreACT test is a multiple choice test designed to provide tenth graders with practice for the ACT test. The PreACT test measures academic achievement in

- English
- Math
- Reading
- Science

English- contains 45 questions and measures written English by conventions of standard English (punctuation, usage, sentence structure and formation)

Math contains 36 items including algebra, geometry, statistics and probability. The test will cover math skills that include percentages, surface area, average and median and volume. Students are allowed to use a calculator, however all questions can be solved without one

Reading- Contains 25 items all about reading comprehension. Students will examine 3 reading passages to test their ability in understanding main ideas, making comparisons, examining cause and effect and so much more!

Science- contains 30 items. The test includes three reporting categories- interpretation of data, scientific investigation, and evaluation of models, inferences and experimental results.

ACT scores range from 1-36 including an overall composite score. Research has found that an average PreACT score for a tenth grader is 18. Anything above that would be considered great for a

tenth grader. If a sophomore was able to score a 24 then they would rank higher than 75 percent nationally of other sophomore scores.

Actual test time will average about 2.5 hours in addition to pre test activity. Social distancing and masks will be enforced with small test settings provided to students.

CONGRATULATIONS DECA CLUB MEMBERS!

This year DECA State Competition was held virtually. Competition included a 100 question test to be completed in 75 minutes with a window of 2/1/21 – 2/19/21. Next the members had to complete 2 role-plays in most events. This had to be completed on select days the week of 2/8/21 – 2/15/21. They had to respond to a business scenario according to the performance indicators, record their response and upload a shareable link of their response to the testing site.



Our students did an incredible job winning multiple awards as listed below. All 45 participants reached proficiency in their events. The Opening session 2/25/21 and Grand Award session 2/27/21 were streamed live and we watched together as a chapter through Microsoft Teams.

All trophy winners can advance to International Competition. In this years competition, our students were awarded 45 medals including three 1st Place medals, two 2nd place medals, four 3rd place medals, one 4th place and one 6th place medal!

*In the event of severe weather, rain dates have been set to reschedule ceremonies. Principals will communicate directly to seniors and their families, if the date of their graduation is changed.

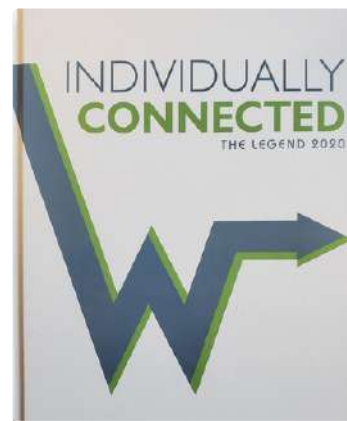


