TECHNOLOGY INVENTORY CHECK

ATTENDANCE REMINDERS

Early Dismissal Procedure

Please note the following reminder for students who need to leave school prior to the end of the school day:

- Students need to provide the Attendance Office a written request from a parent or guardian the morning of the desired dismissal.
- The Attendance Office is open before school from 7:30 to 8am for this purpose.
- The student will be provided an EARLY DISMISSAL pass by the Attendance Office. The pass allows the student to dismiss from class at the said time and come to the school front office.
- **Parents should come to the office to pick the student up.**
- **If the student is a self-driver, they MUST come to the front office to provide their Early Dismissal pass before leaving the building to enter the student parking lot.**

Absences and Teacher Made Final Exam Exemptions

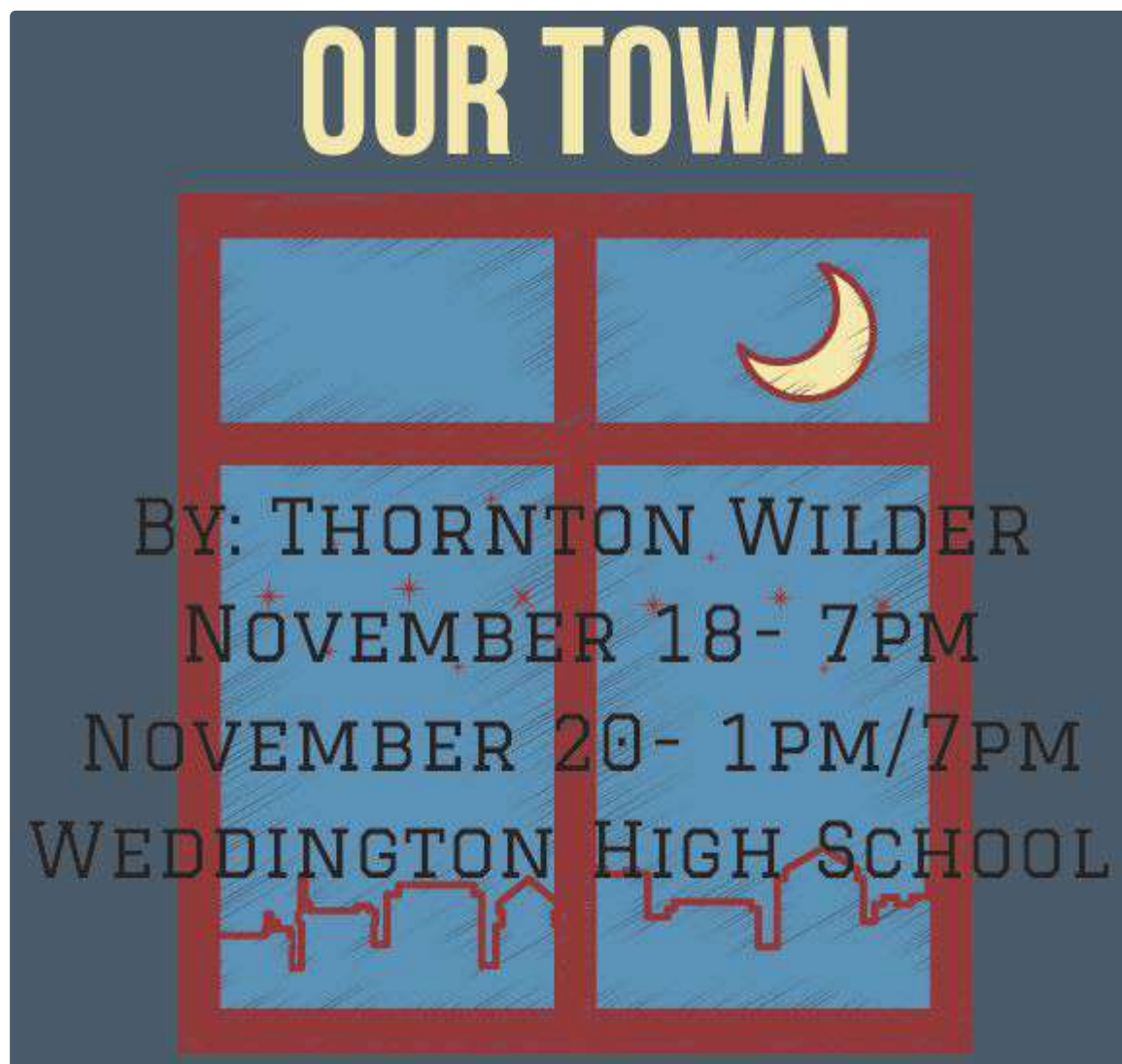
Absences have an impact on whether or not a student can be exempt from a teacher made final exam. The follow excerpt outlines the requirements for teacher made final exam exemptions as is found on

page 22 of the 2021-2022 UCPS High School Student Handbook which can be accessed by clicking [HERE](#).

High School students will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:

- The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam **and has no more than 2 unexcused absences in the class**; or
- The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam **and has no more than 1 unexcused absence in the class**.

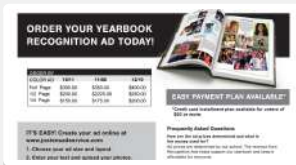
