Theme: Choice

Students will be creating a Watercolor Cover for their Journal/Sketchbook with:

1. a strong composition with
 - a. Foreground
 - b. Midground
 - c. Background
2. 3 objects/images
3. 3 added details like":
 - a. textures
 - b. small details on or near you 3 objects/images
4. 5 colors
5. 5 Watercolor Techniques:
 - a. wet on wet, wet on dry, gradient wash, stippling, sponge, tape , negative, stencil, bubble, sgraffito, dry brush, wax resist, color lift, rubbing alcohol, salt, glitter, blooming, plastic wrap, splatter, straw, and a new creation

Self-Reflection Essay

Inside Front Page Essay/Writing Self-Reflection:

- Introduction: Attention Grabber
- Body I: Discuss the meaning behind your watercolor painting
- Body II: Describe why you picked/used the colors, techniques, imagery, fabrics, and layout/orientation
- Conclusion: Summarize
