At WHS (Wavetown High School) there was a break in.

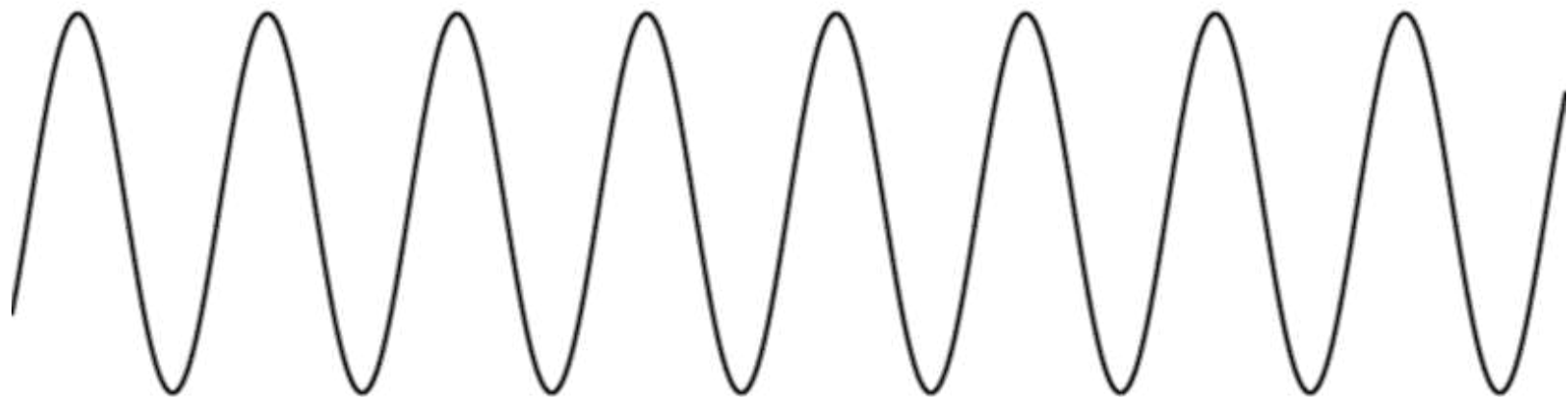

- Then use this data to solve the case on Google Classroom

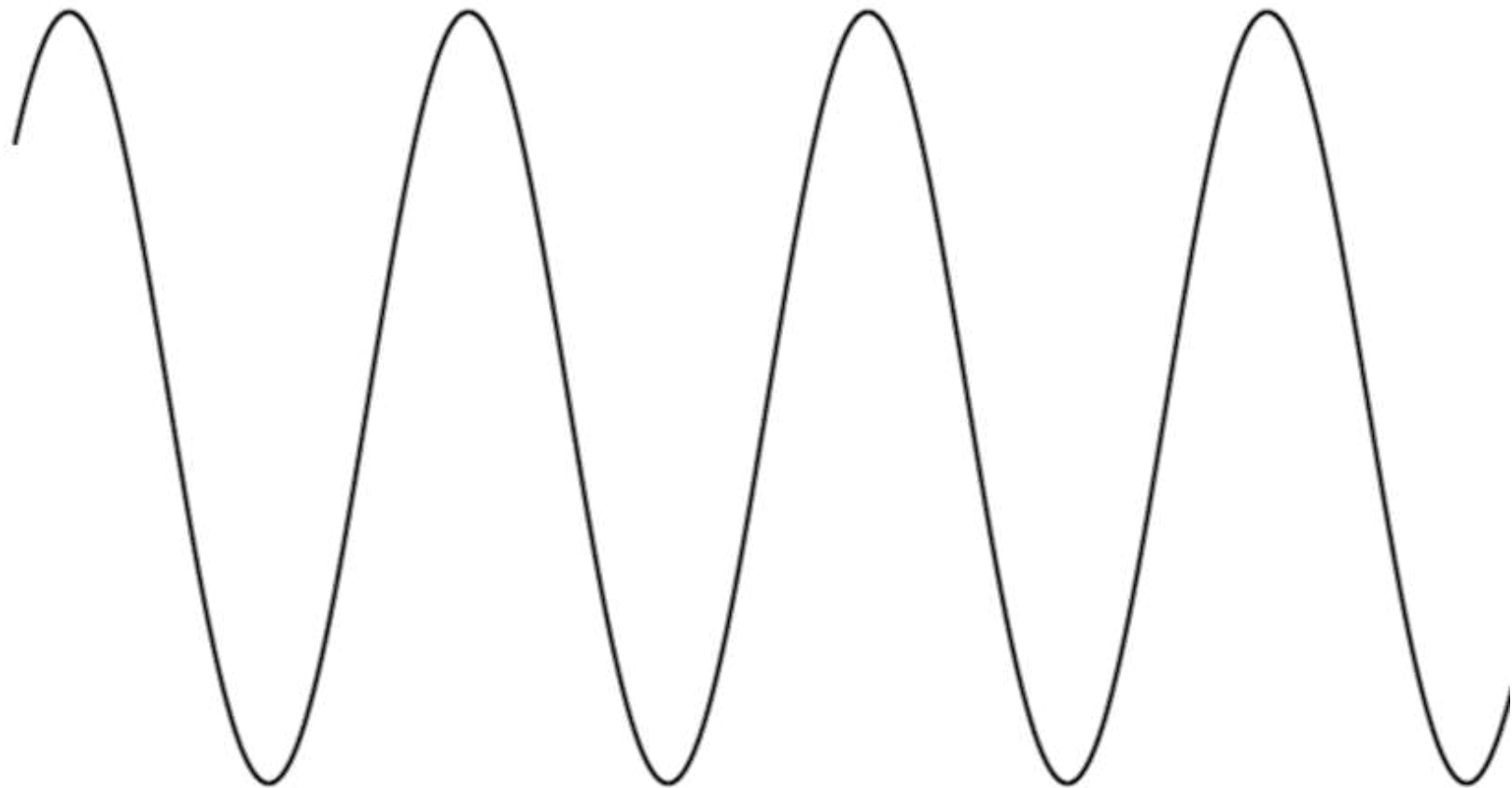
