

Mrs. Gonyo/Mrs. Ternes – English 11A **Book Analysis: Multi-Media Project – 100 points**  
You will create a Website dedicated to your chosen novel on Weebly.com

### **ELEMENTS to be Included on the Website**

- ✓ Title of the novel/author bio
- ✓ Plot structure (brief summary – no endings ruined, please!)
- ✓ The entire Website should be a cohesive representation of the novel (thematic background)
- ✓ Character analysis – at least 2 main characters
- ✓ Central Idea Statement (Universal) – themes?
  - ✓ *The next two items must be presented in a two column format.* Choose one significant passage/paragraph that represents the meaning of the work as a whole and copy the passage exactly from the text with accurate documentation.
  - ✓ Side by side with the significant passage should be a direct line-by-line analysis (figurative language, literary technique, syntax, diction, etc.) and an explanation of how it (the passage) relates to the central idea/theme statement
  - ✓ Music that **directly** relates to the theme (this does not mean that it represents the plot or characters of the novel, rather it **represents the universal idea** present in the work.) The music may play when page is opened electronically, but it doesn't have to. (Document source)
  - ✓ Explanation of 75 - 100 words that explains the connection between the music and the central idea.
  - ✓ Recommendation to readers – did you like the novel? Why or why not?
- ✓ The following graphics – the video portion of the assignment
  - A picture of the cover of the novel
  - An embedded YouTube.com (or other) movie clip that has a thematic connection to the novel (it cannot be the same work). (Document source using format consistent with that used earlier) An explanation of the connection of the film clip to the novel. **OR** an original movie maker show using graphics and words that are representative of the work.
  - Three symbols that are present in the work with brief **explanation** of where the symbol appears in the work and how the symbol functions in the work (either in video or written in website)
