Lesson	Supplies Needed:
Create a flag that tells the world about you. Include 3 of your favorite things, as well as your name in decorative letters.	Piece of copy paper and a straw to tape the flag to. Coloring materials. https://youtu.be/8VRcMT42SSo Video of Mrs. Ladman instructing!
Set up a still life using 5 items. Make sure one is tall, one is medium and one is short. Ideas include fruit, baskets, vases, stuffed animals, toy cars, baseballs, etc. Draw your still life.	Various objects from your house. A flat surface to set them on and a piece of paper to draw on.
Take pictures of objects that look like the letters in your name. (Objects from nature, toys, etc.) Print and glue together.	Phone or camera Paper to print
Build a paper airplane and test how far it flies by sitting down, standing up and then standing on a stool. Design the wings to customize your plane.	Piece of paper, coloring materials and an area to fly the plane. Mark off the distance using masking tape.
Create a puppet using a paper bag or an old sock. Make sure your puppet has features like eyes, nose, mouth and a personality. Write a play for your puppet to perform.	Paper bag, old sock, yarn, buttons, pom poms, hot glue, permanent markers.
