<p>What do students need to do?</p> <p><a href="#"><u>Link to BV instructional video for week of May 18-22</u></a></p>	<p><b>The first 2 items for our grade level celebration party are in the bag we delivered to your doorstep the week of May 11.</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Picture Books/Photos-</b> Look through this book with your child and ask them who their friends are, what they are doing with their friends, etc.</li> <li>2. <b>Bubbles-</b> (end of the year gift from teachers) Go outside and have your child blow bubbles and pop them with index finger or chase the balloons as they blow away</li> <li>3. <b>Ice Cream Sundae Party-</b> Usually on the last day of school we walk to B &amp; G for an ice cream treat so have an ice cream sundae party as a family and ask your child what he/she learned this year, what their favorite activities were, who their friends were and what they remember most.</li> <li>4. <b>Slideshow-</b> Watch the slideshow</li> <li>5. <b>LYNX Farewell Parade (OPTIONAL)</b> - Students and their families are welcome to drive past BE, RBE, FAE, VSE and/or the Brandon Valley Intermediate School on Thursday night from 6:30 - 7:30 pm as BVSD staff wave goodbye and celebrate a great year!
