Fast Shutter Capture Tips

Camera settings

Format card before photographing

Set to **continuous shooting**

Keep holding shutter down to take a burst

White balance: **Auto**

ISO: **Auto**

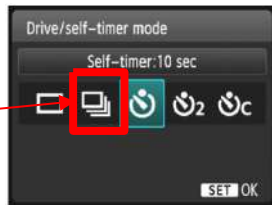
Focus Mode: **AI Servo** for Moving Subjects

Use FOCUS LOCK!!!!!! Keep center focus point of focal point/object moving

Mode: **Tv**

Set shutter speed to about **1/125th of a second and up!**

Image size: **Medium**



Keep in mind these particular rules of composition:

- careful not to cut off or crowd the action
- allow space in the frame for implied movement
- look for diagonal lines to lead the viewer's eye
- choose an interesting viewpoint
- Timing is very important to capture the apex of motion
- Watch out for background distractions
- ❖ **Sharing camera:** take photo the person before you switch, so you know who's photos they are.

Adobe Bridge Notes (Br) video demo

- Program to sort, delete, and rename your photos (a way to look at your photos)
- NOT a way to save photos
- Can look at your Metadata to see your settings
- Can delete photos we don't want. Right click > delete
- MAKE SURE you want them deleted because they are not coming back!
- Whatever you do in Bridge will affect your server folder
- Can put a **star rating on photos by CTRL 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5**
- Sort my rated photos by clicking View > Sort > Rating
- Double click on photo will open it in Photoshop.
- Space bar make full screen, hit space bar again to exit.
