Groups of people get together and enjoy creating music and songs.

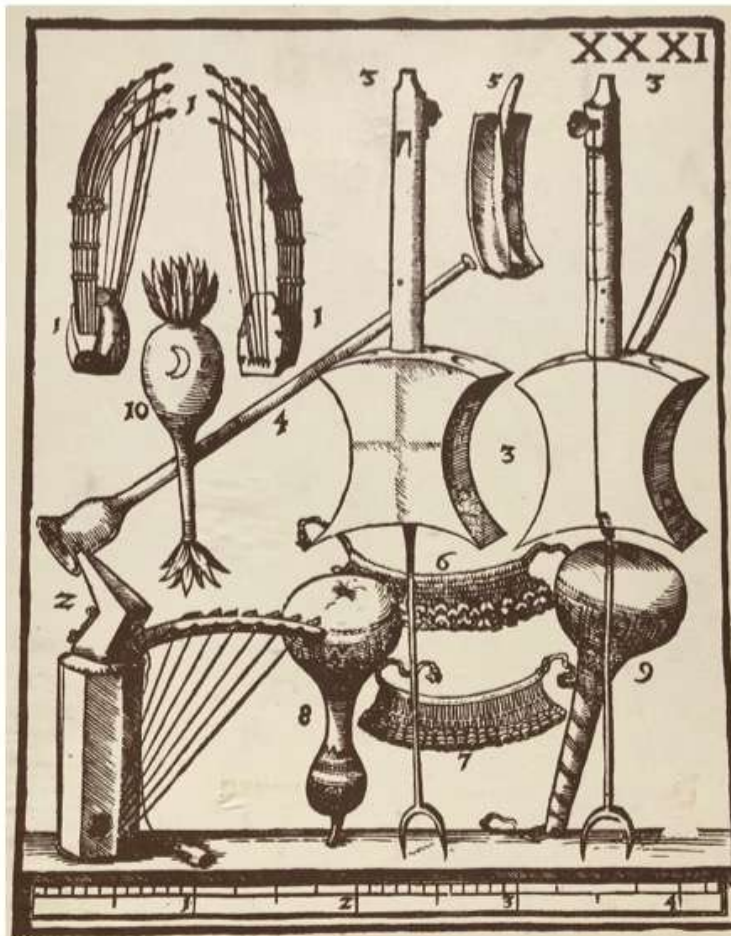
This part of the lesson looks at different musical instruments.

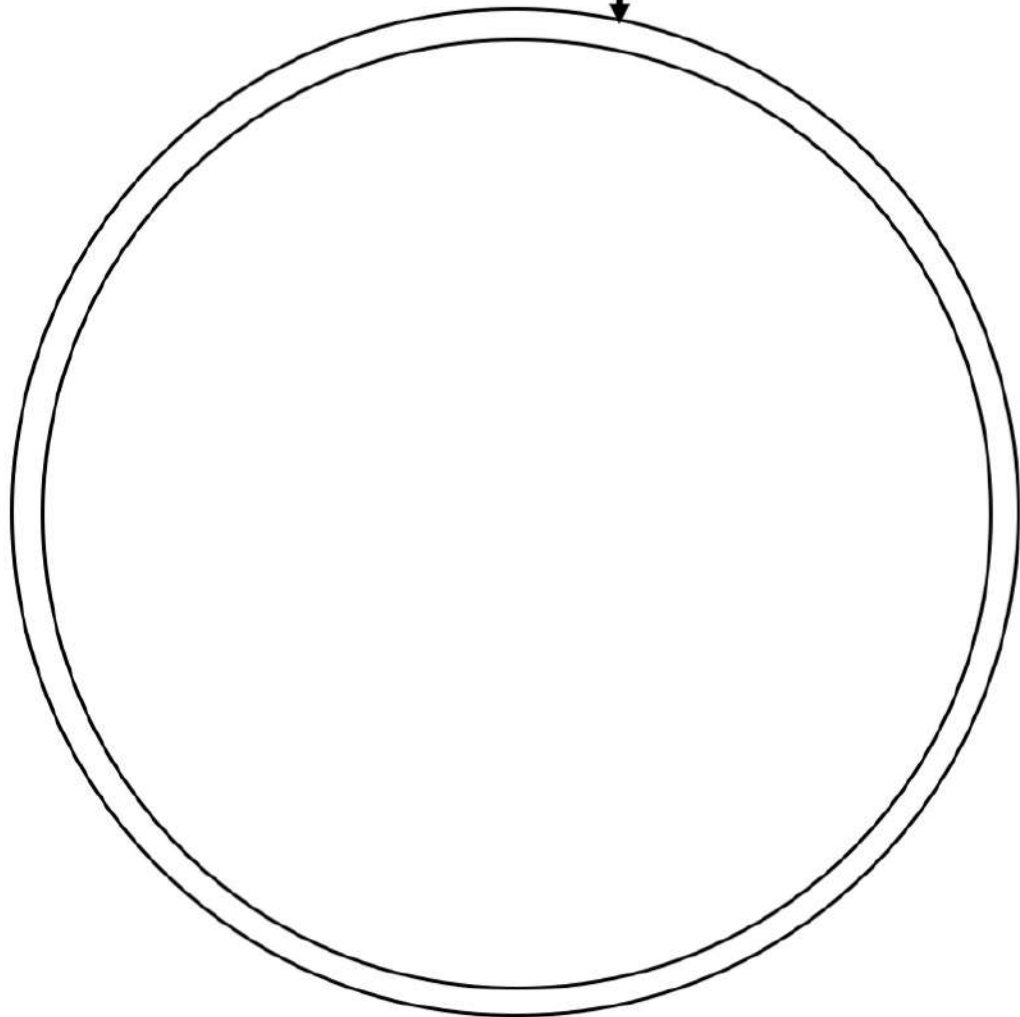
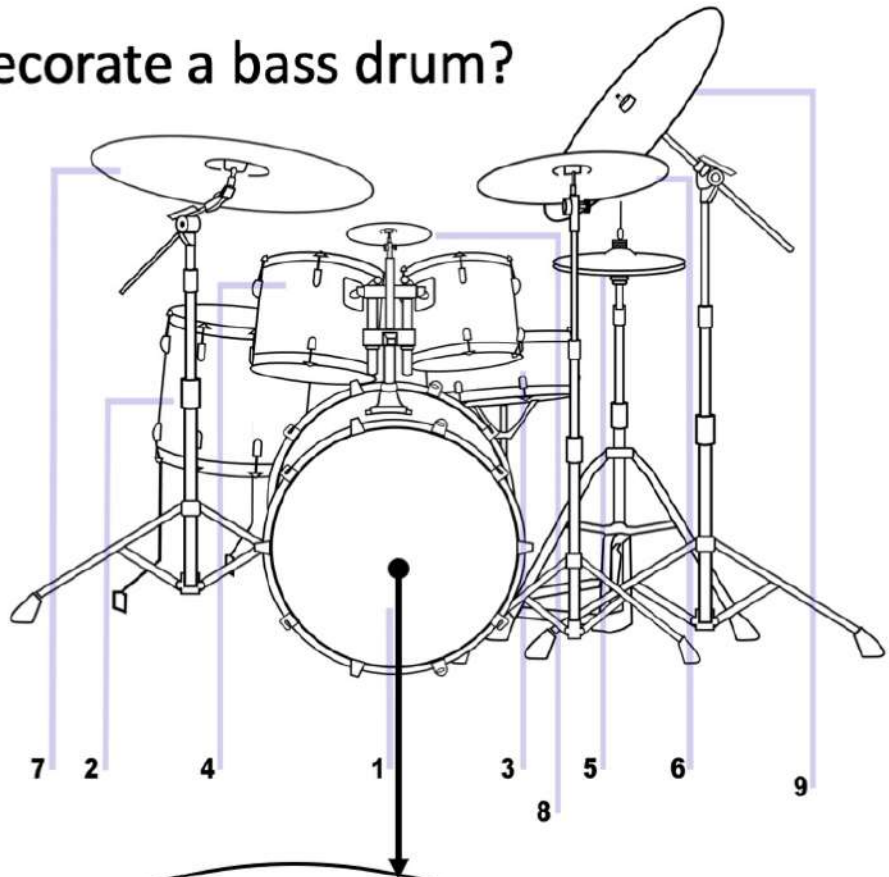

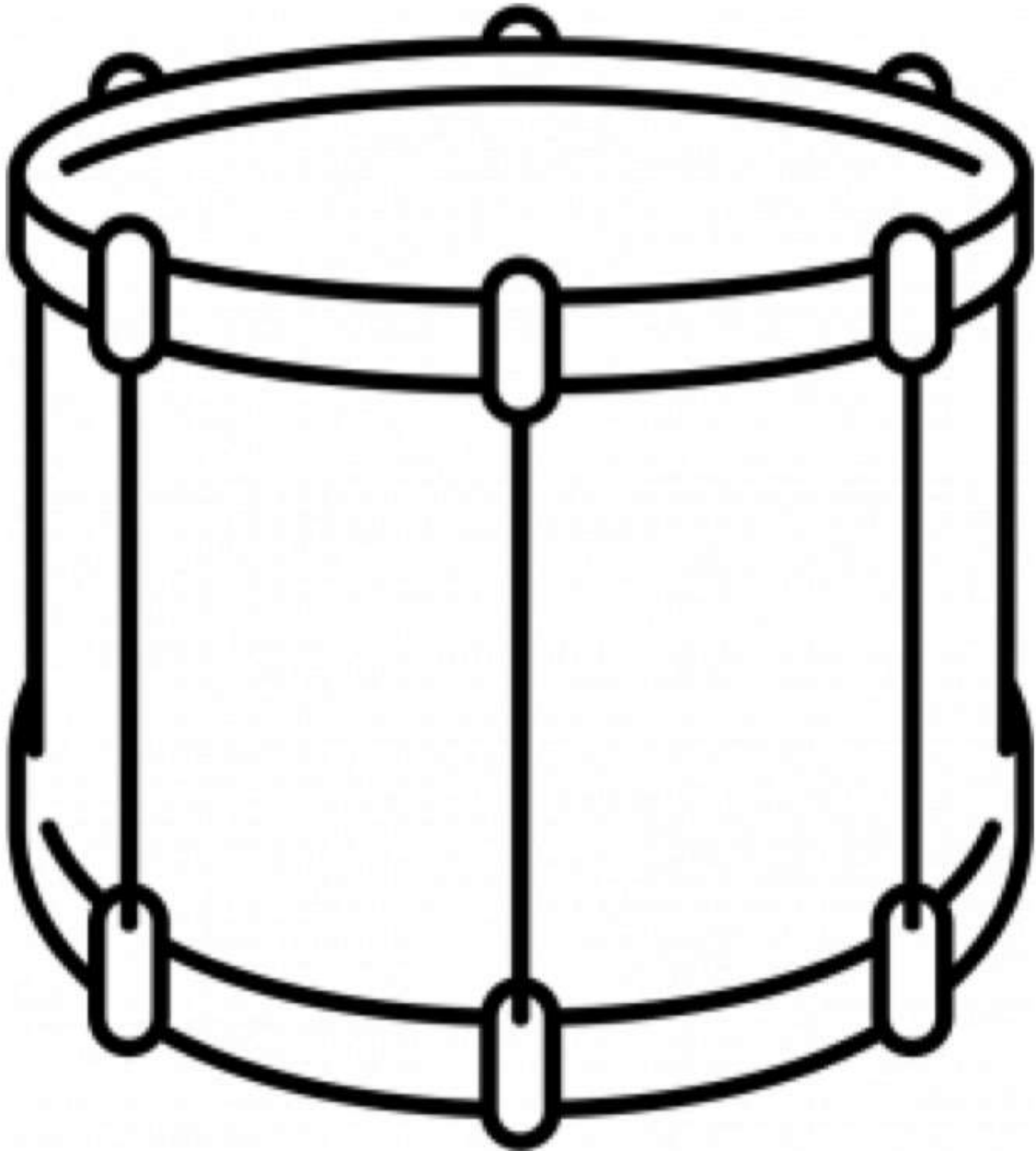


How would you decorate a bass drum?

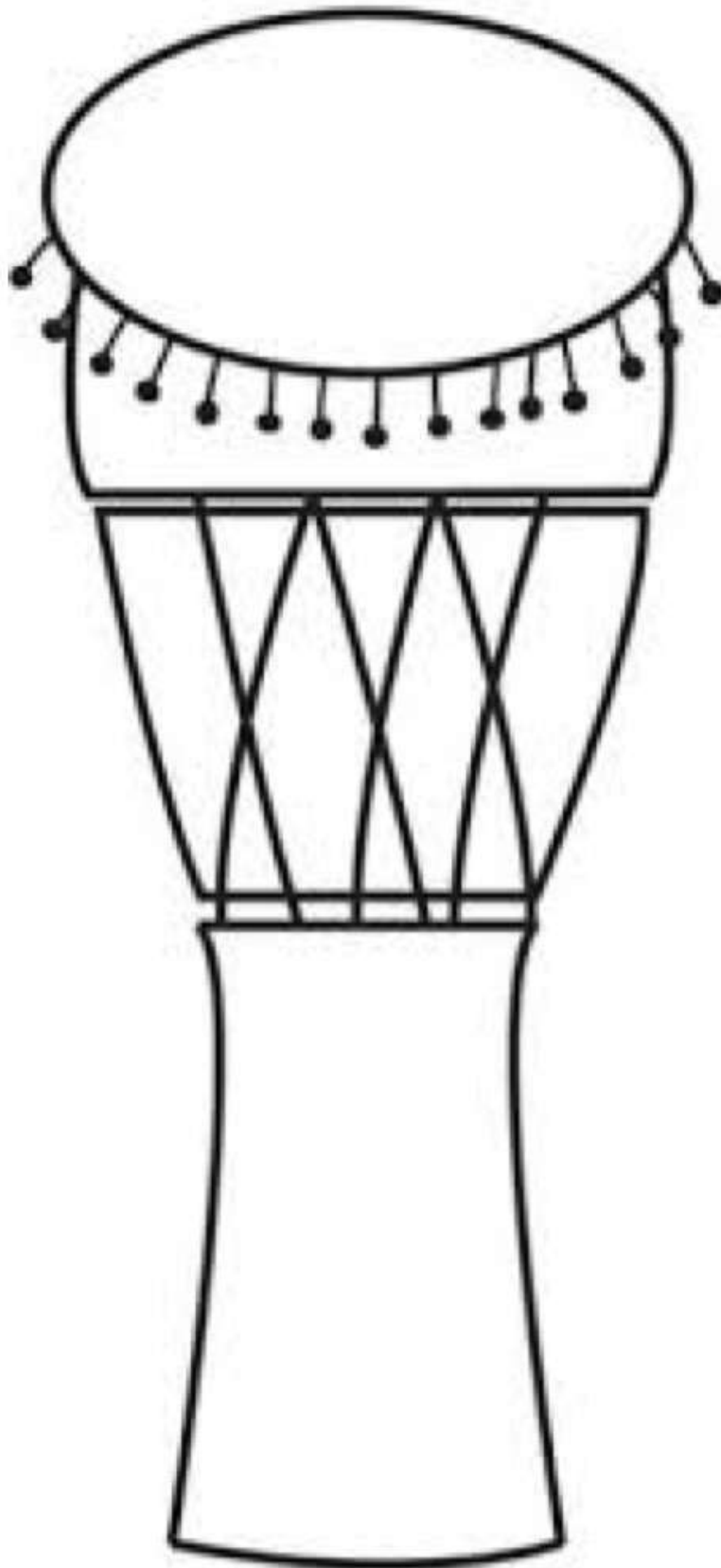
- (1) Bass drum

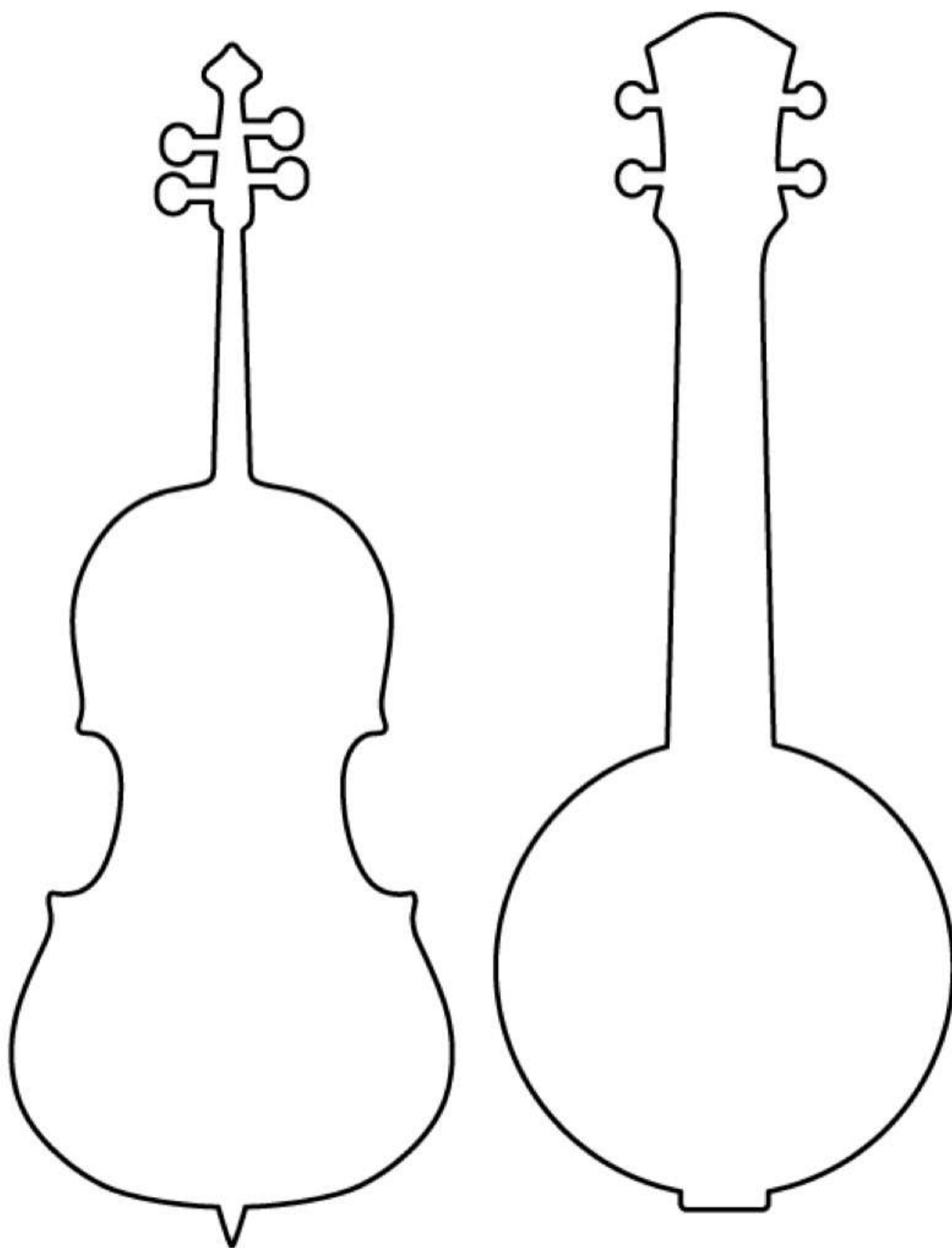

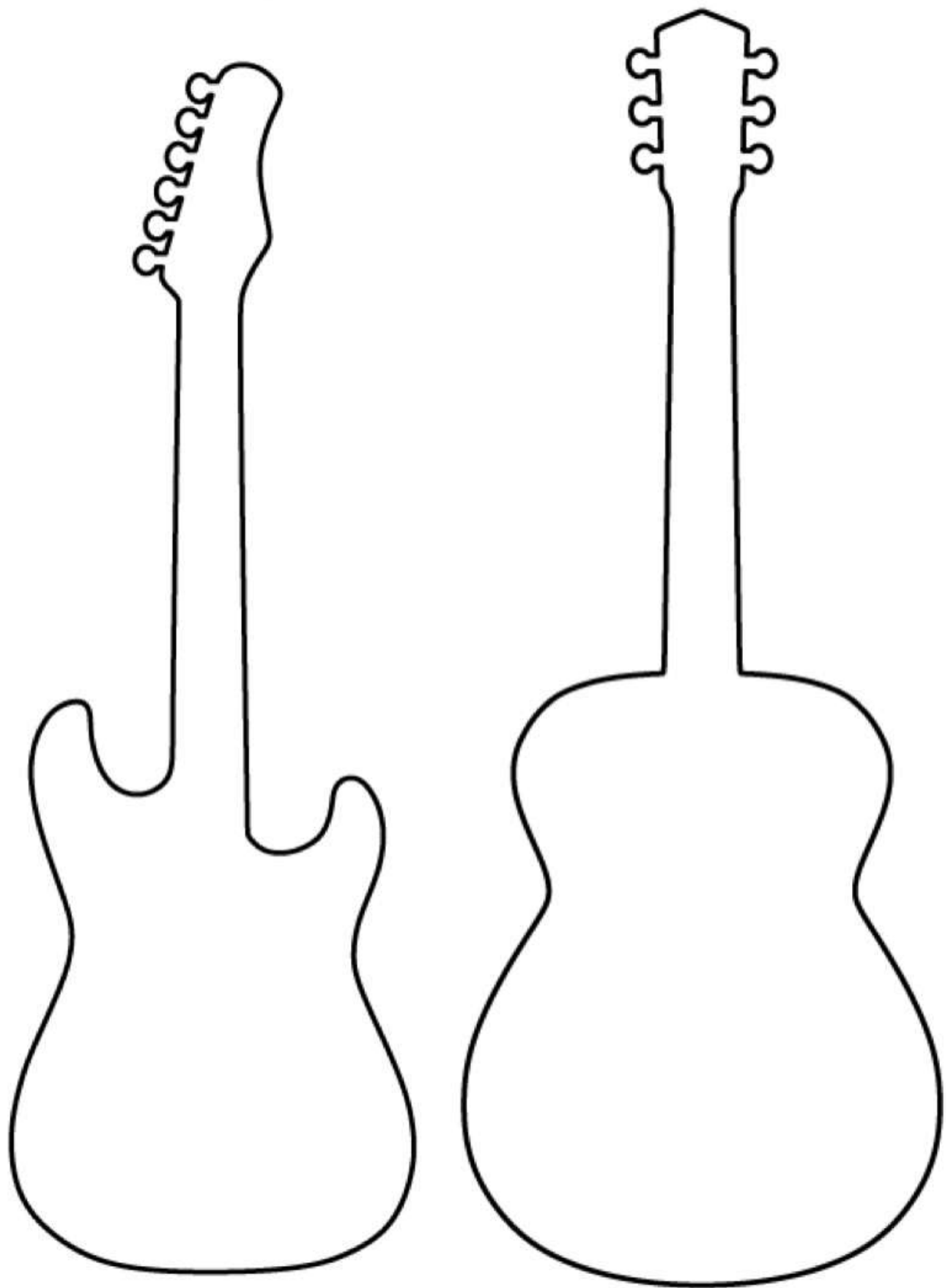

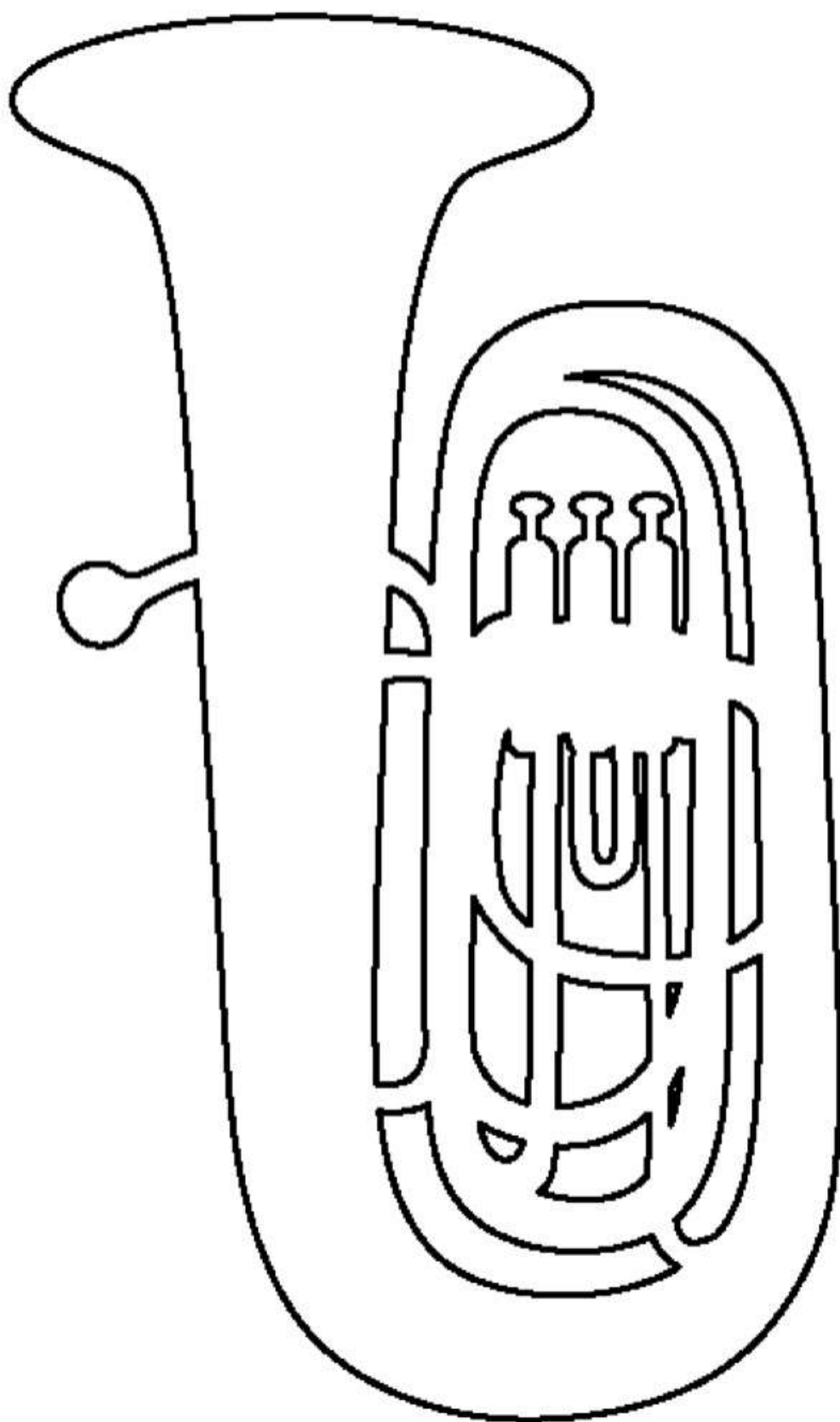

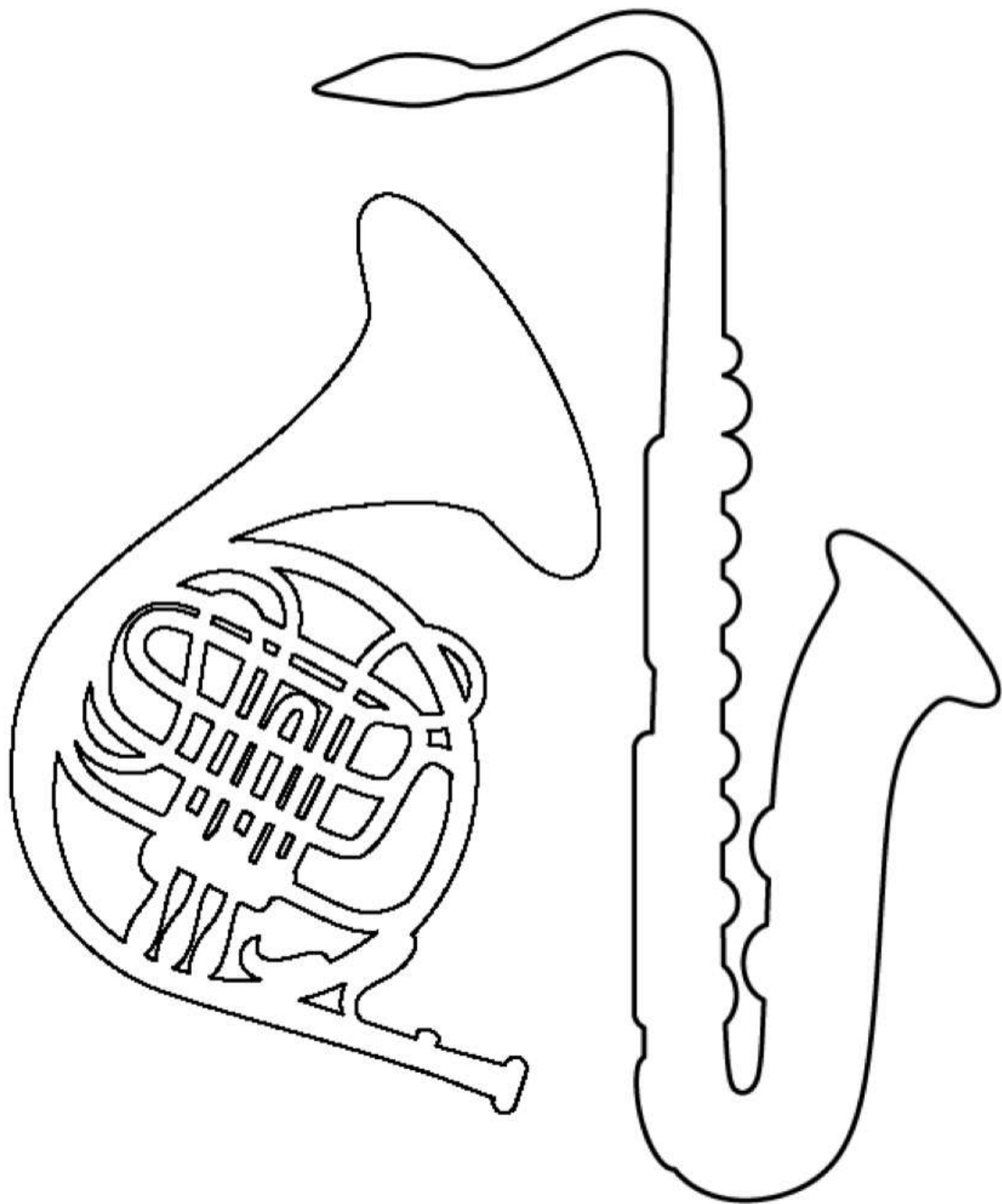
