Create a newspaper and masking tape structure. Roll the newspaper into tubes and tape together with masking tape. A cube? A pyramid? A tunnel? What can you make?	Masking tape and old newspapers. https://modernparentsmessykids.com/play/
Color on a coffee filter with washable markers. Make sure to put something underneath while you work! Spray water onto the coffee filter to see what the colors do! <i>*tip: fold the filter first like a snowflake!*</i>	Washable markers Coffee filter Something to cover work surface
Create a color wheel using solid colored objects found in your house! Toys, food, socks, etc! Remember to place the items in a circle, in color order: Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple!	Whatever you can find in your house! Something to take a picture from above! 
Parent Help required: Warm & Cool Color Creation: Peel and shave old crayons with a vegetable peeler. Put shavings between two pieces of waxed paper. Iron on <u>low</u> to create a stained glass effect.
