### 1. Sight/Trick Word Practice

This week I'd like to focus on making sure that everyone is still practicing their trick words. If you have not started, this is a great week to start!

Refer to the list attached, pick 2-3 words that your child needs to learn to read and spell. Start flashcards for these words. Many times these are words that cannot be "sounded out" - therefore they must be practiced in different ways. See the list below for ideas on how to practice these words in fun ways.

#### Trick Word Practice:

- Explain to your child what the word says and how it is pronounced. Use it in a sentence to show how the word is used.
- Explain what makes the word tricky - why it can't be sounded out (usually)
- Practice writing the word in fun material - chalk, white board markers, sand, mud etc. Encourage your child to read the word out loud as he/she spells.
- Practice building the word with magnets or letter cards (if you have them).

Pick 3 words from this list, and write a sentence using each word in a sentence. Type up your sentences and send them to Mrs. Wescott in an email.
